Wednesday
June 22nd. First of these 24 hours strong. Went hard by
wind with much rain mid & latter parts h w
wind & better weather so ends this day Lat 26.21 Long 175.31

Thursday
June 23rd. First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate
breeze from N.W. B K steering N.W. & saw several
Pinbacks to day mid & latter parts light variable
wind saw B K. A lark to the leeward also saw a Pinback
so ends this day Lat 26.21 Long 175.14

Friday
June 24th. First of these 24 hours light southerly wind
at half past 1. Put downed 2. Boat & the Capt
went on board the Alaska mid & latter parts weather
the same so ends this day Lat 26.25 Long 174.49

Saturday
June 25th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate
breeze from the N. still gambling with the Alaska
at night shortened sail mid & latter parts day
weather & passing shower saw a small whitewater
to day so ends this day Lat 25.38 Long 174.05

Sunday
June 26th. First of these 24 hours variable winds with frequent
squalls mid & latter parts weather much the same
so ends this day no obs

Monday
June 27th. First of these 24 hours variable winds & much
rain. B K steering N.W. & saw a lark & a lark bottom
mid & latter parts better weather so ends this day
Lat 23.52 Long 174.06

Tuesday
June 28th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & southerly winds. B K
steering N.W. saw one Pinback mid & latter parts strong
breeze so ends this day Lat 21.85 Long 174.14

June 29th. First of these 24 hours day weather & strong breeze
from E. B K steering N.W. & at dark shortened sail
& luffed to the wind heading to the southward
mid & latter parts strong breeze at daylight raised
the Island of Savu kept ship off for it so ends no obs

Thursday
June 30th. First of these 24 hours strong E wind & day
weather at 2 hours. Put came to anchor in Tongabara
in 15 fathoms water mid & latter parts equally weather
shifted in our gibboons to day so ends this day

Friday
July 1st. First of these 24 hours strong Easterly winds
hands employed repairing. B K & fly B K. g
mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day

Saturday
July 2nd. First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze
from the Eastward hands busily employed on boats
Crew on shore cutting wood mid & latter parts much the
same sent out a new gibboon to day so ends this day

Sunday
July 3rd. First of these 24 hours fine weather hands employed
cutting wood & setting up head rigging mid & latter parts
blowing fresh from the Eastward so ends this day

Monday
July 4th. First of these 24 hours blowing hard from the Eastward
mid parts the same latter part more moderate hands
employed in various jobs boat decks & some cutting
wood so ends this day

Tuesday
July 5th. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & variable
winds hands employed in various jobs boat
decks mid & latter parts strong breeze with frequent
squalls of rain so ends this day
