- Monday
August 1st. First of these 24 hours thick weather with passing showers hands employed cutting & lubber mid & latter parts rained started to boil at 4 hours and at 5 lowered the Boats so ends this day
- Tuesday
Aug 2nd. First of these 24 hours thick rainy weather & variable winds Boats came on board at 2 P.M. mid & latter parts rained finished boiling at 1. and so ends this day
- Wednesday
Aug 3rd. First of these 24 hours strong breeze from E. N. E. with much rain mid & latter parts cloudy weather lowered 3 Boats this morning for whale records
- Thursday
Aug 4th. First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind with rain Boats came on board at 3 P.M. mid & latter parts blowing fresh lowered the Boats this morning so ends this day
- Friday
Aug 5th. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from the Eastward Boats came on board at 3 P.M. mid & latter parts weather much the same hands employed in taking out & stowing down oil Lewis Hooker back & Carpenter off duty sick
- Saturday
Aug 6th. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from the Eastward mid & latter parts the same lowered the Boats to day to cruise for Hump back so ends
- Sunday
Aug 7th. First of these 24 hours strong N. E. wind Boats cruising for whales mid part the same latter part rained so ends this day

- Monday
Aug 8th. First of these 24 hours variable winds & cloudy weather moved the ship further out this morning then lowered the Boats to cruise so ends this day
- Tuesday
Aug 9th. First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind at 2 hours. P.M. the L. R. struck a whale & set him to spouting blood & the whale rounded & took the line the red line several hours & at dark came on board mid & latter parts weather the same lowered the Boats this morning to cruise so ends
- Wednesday
Aug 10th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & strong Easterly wind Boats came on board at half past 4 P.M. mid & latter parts the same lowered the Boats this morning to cruise so ends this day Carpenter came
- Thursday
Aug 11th. First of these 24 hours strong breeze from the E. Boats came on board at 5 P.M. mid & latter parts blowing fresh lowered 3 Boats to day so ends
- Friday
Aug 12th. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from E. N. E. Boats came on board at 4 P.M. mid & latter parts the same lowered the Boats this morning but came back at 11. A.M. so ends this day
- Saturday
Aug 13th. First of these 24 hours weather improving lowered 2 Boats this afternoon & the L. R. got a whale got him to the ship at half past 6 P.M. mid & latter parts strong breeze lowered the Boats to day & the L. R. struck a whale killed him but he got stove the James. Arnolds Boats struck a whale & got 3 Boats stove so the L. R. & B. B. lodged kill there whale for half so ends this day
