

Remarks on board Bk

Nov 11th
Friday First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze from N.E. ship standing off shore mid & latter parts fine weather saw small school of sperm whales lowered for them & the W.B. got one so ends this day

Nov 12th
Saturday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable wind took over whale to the ship & cut him in mid & latter parts weather much the same Lat 29.37 Long 168.37 ends this day

Nov 13th
Sunday First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.W. wind hands employed boiling Sealed in sight all day mid & latter parts weather much the same finished boiling at 5. AM so ends this day Lat 29.36

Nov 14th
Monday First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.W. wind R.K. steering by the wind saw pumps to day mid & latter parts strong breeze so ends this day Lat 29.36 Long 168.37

Nov 15th
Tuesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & a strong breeze from N.E. R.K. steering by the wind mid & latter parts the same so ends this day Lat 29.43

Nov 16th
Wednesday First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong Easterly winds R.K. steering by the wind Sealed in sight mid & latter parts thick weather so ends

Nov 17th
Thursday First of these 24 hours thick rainy weather & Easterly wind saw 2 pumps & the Sealed mid & latter parts fine weather saw 2 seals close in to the Sealed so ends Lat 29.51

Nov 18th
Friday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air from the Eastward lowered 2 Boats for a Humpback but could not get near them mid & latter parts calm so ends this day Lat 28.50 Long 168.23

Nov 19th
Saturday First of these 24 hours fine weather & a light breeze from N.W. R.K. steering by the wind Sealed in sight mid & latter parts thick rainy weather so ends this day Lat 28.56 Long 168.25

Nov 20th
Sunday First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.W. wind R.K. steering by the wind Sealed in sight mid & latter parts weather much the same had one rain squall to day so ends Lat 29.22 Long 168.28

Nov 21st
Monday First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze from N.W. R.K. steering by the wind saw a Humpback also saw the Sealed at dark. shortened sail mid & latter parts the same hands employed repairing Main & gallant sails so ends this day No. 1

Nov 22nd
Tuesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & calm sent down our foretopails for repairs & bent other ones at night shortened sail mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 29.44 Long 168.53

Nov 23rd
Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds finished repairing lower topsail to day Sealed in sight mid part much the same latter parts rainy so ends this day Lat 29.39
