Dec 6th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light
N. E. wind. B.H. steering by the wind heading N by E
saw Porpoises also saw plenty of Sulphur bottoms
mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends
this day Lat 29.13 Long 159.33

Dec 7th

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light
air. B.H. steering N by E hands employed setting
up foretopmast backstays fore & main. Topmast
backstays & jib & fly jib guys mid & latter parts calm
so ends this day Lat 29.33 Long 159.40

Dec 8th

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & calm
hands employed setting up main rigging mid
& latter parts weather the same so ends this day
Lat 29.40 Long 159.44

Dec 9th

Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & calm hands
employed setting up fore. Main rigging
mid & latter parts light winds from the Northward
saw Blackfish to day covered the N. B. B. B. &
Starboard. Boats for them but did not get fast
also saw a sail steering to N.W. so ends this day
Lat 30.06 Long 159.32

Dec 10th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a moderate
breeze from N.W. B.H. steering different courses
mid & latter parts cloudy weather & strong
breeze so ends this day Lat 31.12

Dec 11th

Sunday. First of these 24 hours strong N.W. wind with
much rain. B.H. steering S.W. mid & latter parts
fine weather at 5. And raised Boat Hoist. In lunch
rizen head so ends this day Lat 31.31 Long 158.17

Dec 12th

Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & calm. Land
in sight all day also saw Finbacks & Grampuses
at night Land bore E by N. 40 miles distant mid
& latter parts light variable winds so ends this day
Lat 31.44 Long 158.06

Dec 13th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours squally with variable
winds. B.H. steering N by E by the wind. Land
in sight all day also saw a Finback mid & latter
part light air from N.E. so ends this day
Lat 32.00 Long 158.32

Dec 14th

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air
from N.E. B.H. steering N by E & land in sight all
day also saw a school of Grampuses mid & latter
parts weather much the same so ends this day
Lat 32.27 Long 158.42

Dec 15th

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a moderate
breeze from the N. B.H. steering N by E mid & latter
parts weather much the same so ends this day
Lat 33.58 Long 159.03

Dec 16th

Friday. First of these 24 hours thick squally weather
with passing showers at 4 P.M. wind shifted to S.E.
B.H. steering by the wind on Port tack mid & latter
parts fine weather saw one sunfish to day so ends
Lat 34.34 Long 159.17

Dec 17th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours hazy weather P.N.E.
wind. B.H. steering N by E mid & latter parts
weather much the same saw several schools
of Porpoises to day so ends Lat 35.37 Long 159.07
