March 9<sup>th</sup>

Thursday First of these 24 hours day weather & a fresh breeze from E. N. E. R. H. steering by the wind mid mid & latter parts strong breeze so ends this day  
Lat 32.48 Long 178.52 W

March 10<sup>th</sup>

Friday First of these 24 hours day weather & strong E. wind R. H. steering by the wind saw one sail mid & latter parts blowing fresh so ends this day Lat 32.30 Long 179.48 W

March 11<sup>th</sup>

Saturday First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from E. N. E. R. H. under lower topsails & staysails steering by the wind mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day  
Lat 32.05 Long 179.40 W

March 12<sup>th</sup>

Sunday First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong Easterly wind R. H. under short sail steering by the wind mid & latter blowing a gale & laying to under lower maintop sail & staysail so ends this day Lat 32.11 Long 179.52 E

March 13<sup>th</sup>

Monday First of these 24 hours following a gale from the Eastward R. H. laying to under lower maintop sail & staysails mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day  
Lat 32.44 Long 179.36 E

March 14<sup>th</sup>

Tuesday First of these 24 hours blowing a gale from E. N. E. with frequent squalls of rain R. H. laying to under lower maintop sail & staysails mid & latter parts the same so ends this day Lat 33.24 Long 179.25 E

March 15<sup>th</sup>

Wednesday First of these 24 hours still blowing a gale from the same quarter mid & latter parts more moderate set fore topsail & foresail & wore ship so ends this day Lat 34.03 Long 179.08 E

March 16<sup>th</sup>

Thursday First of these 24 hours still blowing hard from E. N. E. R. H. under lower topsails & courses steering by the wind mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day  
Lat 33.26 Long 178.32

March 17<sup>th</sup>

Friday First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind R. H. steering by the wind under topsails & courses mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day Lat 32.27 Long 178.16 E

March 18<sup>th</sup>

Saturday First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind R. H. steering by the wind heading N. mid & latter parts weather the same stored down our oil to day so ends Lat 31.40 Long 178.03 E

March 19<sup>th</sup>

Sunday First of these 24 hours fresh breeze from the Eastward R. H. steering by the wind on starboard tack mid & latter parts more moderate so ends this day Lat 31.29 Long 177.57

March 20<sup>th</sup>

Monday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Easterly wind R. H. steering by the wind on Port tack saw a white water on our weather bow but never saw it but once mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day  
Lat 31.45 Long 178.07 E

March 21<sup>st</sup>

Tuesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds & calm mid & latter parts westerly wind R. H. steering E so ends this day Lat 31.52 Long 179.23 E

March 22<sup>nd</sup>

Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze from the Southward R. H. steering E by N mid & latter parts the same so ends this day Lat 31.30 Long 179.23 W

March 23<sup>rd</sup>

Thursday First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze from S. E. R. H. steering N. E. by N French Rock in sight mid & latter parts Easterly wind raised Gusts. Rocks & Goat Island at day light so ends this day Lat 30.33 Long 178.34
