Friday First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind
saw one Pinback boat in sight all day mid & latter
parts weather much the same rain & Sunday Island at daylight
so ends this day Lat 29.52 Long 179.44 W
- March 25th
Saturday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable
wind. B K steering by the wind and different parts mid
& latter parts equally so ends Lat 30 Long 179.31 W
- March 26th
Sunday First of these 24 hours strong & southerly winds
with passing squalls mid & latter parts blowing fresh
so ends this day Lat 29.47 Long 178.52 W
- March 27th
Monday First of these 24 hours blowing & gale from the south
B K lying to under lower main topsail & staysails
mid & Port tack mid part weather much the same latter
part more moderate made more sail so ends this day
Lat 29.29 Long 179.37 W
- March 28th
Tuesday First of these 24 hours strong southerly wind
B K under topsail & courses steering by the wind
mid & Port tack mid & latter parts fine weather
so ends this day Lat 29.16 Long 179.05 W
- March 29th
Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light southerly
wind. B K steering by the wind Sunday Island
in sight mid & latter part light wind & calms so ends
this day Lat 29.19 Long 178.58 W
- March 30th
Thursday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light Easterly
wind. B K steering by the wind mid & Port tack boat
in sight all day mid & latter parts strong breeze
saw a steamer steering to the N.E. so ends this day
Lat 30.03 Long 179.48 W

parts blowing & gale one sail in sight so ends this day
Lat 30.30 Long 179.38 E
- April 1st
Saturday First of these 24 hours blowing a fresh Gale from
S.E. B K steering by the wind under lower topsails &
staysails one sail in sight mid & latter parts weather
the same & Sunday with B K. Adeline Gibbs Capt
Read so ends this day Lat 30.21
- April 2nd
Sunday First of these 24 hours blowing hard from S.E.
finished gaging at 6 P.M. mid & latter parts weather
the same so ends this day Lat 29.54 Long 179.54 E
- April 3rd
Monday First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from S.E. B K
steering by the wind under lower topsails fore & aft
& staysails. Ansel Gibbs in sight all day mid
part weather much the same latter part more moderate
so ends this day Lat 29.42 Long 179.14 W
- April 4th
Tuesday First of these 24 hours strong breeze from the
Southard named with the Adeline Gibbs
to day mid & latter parts weather the same so ends
this day Lat 29.43 Long 178.43 W
- April 5th
Wednesday First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong
southerly wind. B K steering by the wind
Sunday Island & one sail in sight mid & latter
parts fine weather so ends this day Lat 29.38 Long 179.02 W
- April 6th
Thursday First of these 24 hours fine weather & moderate breeze from the
Southard one sail in sight mid & latter parts light air so ends
this day Lat 29.40 Long 178.36 W
