

Remarks on board B. K.

- April 7th
Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air from the Northward. Sunday Island Goat Island & one sail in sight mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day Lat 28.47 Long 178.32 W
- April 8th
Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light S.W. wind (B. K. steering) & by W Sunday Island Goat Island & one sail in sight mid & latter part strong breeze from the N. 3 sail in sight so ends this day Lat 30.27 Long 178.53 W
- April 9th
Sunday. First of these 24 hours thick cloudy weather & a strong breeze from the Northward. B. K. steering different courses mid & latter parts much rain & no Oils
- April 10th
Monday. First of these 24 hours variable winds with much rain mid & latter parts the same so ends this day Lat 31.18 Long 178.40 W
- April 11th
Tuesday. First of these 24 hours light N.W. winds & cloudy weather. B. K. steering & by E at night luffed to the wind on starboard tack mid & latter parts fine weather cleared with ship California Capt. Brightman so ends this day Lat 31.36 Long 178.02
- April 12th
Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & westerly wind 2 sail in sight mid & latter parts weather much the same at 8 hours. Am raised the California & our weather guater whaling made all sail & stood after her whales going quick at 11. Am raised & going to leeward lowered the Boats for him so ends this day no Oils whales raised by George Harding

Robert Morrison A.D. 1882

- April 13th
Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & westerly winds Boats in chase of whales at 3. P.M. the W. B. took large whale L. B. took second. Boat killed him & took him to the ship at 5. P.M. mid & latter parts light winds & calm hooked on to our whale at 6. Am so ends this day no Oils
- April 14th
Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & hands employed cutting in got his head off & baddy in at 5. P.M. saw one sail to day mid & latter parts fine weather took in our junk & baled the case so ends this day
- April 15th
Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind hands employed cutting junk & boiling mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 31.19 Long 178.32 W
- April 16th
Sunday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light E. wind B. K. steering by the wind saw one sail & hands employed boiling mid & latter parts weather much the same saw one sail & Goat Island so ends this day Lat 30.51 Long
- April 17th
Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a strong breeze from E. finished boiling at 4. P.M. gamed with the California mid & latter parts strong breeze hands employed stowing down so ends this day no Oils
- April 18th
Tuesday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & a strong breeze from the Eastward finished stowing down our oil at 4. P.M. saw one sail & at dark Goat Island was quite handy off our lee beam mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 30.29 Long 178.38 W
- April 19th
Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & N.E. wind B. K. steering we dined by different courses saw one sail & the boat mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day no Oils
