

Remarks on board R H

July 24th
Monday. First of these 24 hours thick weather & a strong breeze from NW mid & latter parts moderate breeze. Port watch came on board to day & the steward came with them as ends this day

July 25th
Tuesday. First of these 24 hours thick weather & NW wind with passing showers at 3 hours. PM took air. Anchor & dropped farther out came to anchor at 6 PM in 11 fathoms water mid & latter parts thick weather as ends this day

July 26th
Wednesday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & SE wind at 2 PM took air anchor and dropped it again at 3 PM in 14 fathoms water mid & latter parts fine weather at half past 11 PM took air. Anchor & went to sea as ends

July 27th
Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & SE wind dropped down. Anchor at 1 PM 6 miles to the windward of Annamooa in 25 fathoms water mid & latter parts strong Easterly wind lowered the Boats and cruised for whales as ends this day

July 28th
Friday. First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind Boats came on board at 2 PM mid & latter parts strong breeze lowered 2 Boats at 11 AM for a Cow and calf the W. B struck the S. B struck soon after we got stove the Moats got hurt came to the ship & the Capt went down as ends

July 29th
Saturday. First of these 24 hours strong. NE winds got the whale dead at 1 PM & hooked on to towed to 11 to work night then 2 Boats came to the ship & left 2 Boats. Anchor red with the whale mid & latter parts weather the same the other 2 Boats let go of the whale this morning and got to the ship at 8 AM as ends

July 30th
Sunday. First of these 24 hours strong breeze from NW & hands employed getting the Boats ready mid & latter part fine weather found our whale and got him to the ship at 10 AM hooked on & began cutting as ends this day. Moats off duty sick

Aug 1st
Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & NE winds finished cutting our whale at 2 PM started to boil mid part fine weather latter part raining 2 Boats went off to day to look for whales finished boiling at 11 AM as ends this day

Aug 1st
Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & variable wind mid & latter parts the same lowered 3 Boats this morning to look for whales as ends this day

Aug 2nd
Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly winds the W. B struck a whale at 2 PM got him alongside at half past 5 PM mid & latter parts strong breeze cut in our whale this morning as ends this day
Moats off duty sick

Aug 3rd
Thursday. First of these 24 hours strong breeze from E & hands busily employed Boat decks mid & latter parts blowing hard started the works this morning as ends this day

Aug 4th
Friday. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from the East hands employed boiling finished at 4 PM mid & latter parts weather much the same as ends this day

Aug 5th
Saturday. First of these 24 hours strong. NE wind and cloudy weather mid & latter parts raining as ends this day. Moats came on duty to day
