Dec 22nd

Friday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & Easterly wind. B K steering W by N mid & latter parts light winds saw plenty of Porpoises to day John W C Leaveland came on duty to day so ends this day Lat 33 15 Long 156.07

Dec 23rd

Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather light variable wind. B K steering N by W mid & latter parts steering to the N E mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day Lat 33 29 Long 154.48 E

Dec 24th

Sunday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & North by wind. B K steering N by W mid & latter parts squally weather 2 sail in sight so ends this day Lat 33 41 Long 152.48 E

Dec 25th

Monday. First of these 24 hours squally weather. B K steering by the wind heading N W mid & latter parts clearing fresh saw one bird so ends this day Lat 34.23 Long 151.41 E

Dec 26th

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours strong N E wind. B K steering under short sail raised the Land at 6 P.M. at 5 A.M. took a Pilot off Sydney Heads & came to Anchor at 7 A.M. in 10 fathoms water but weighed. Anchor at 10 A.M. & went farther up towards the City so ends

Dec 27th

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather variable winds hands employed washing ship mid & latter parts weather much the same hands busily employed boat decks so ends

Dec 28th

Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light southerly winds mid & latter parts the same hands employed in various jobs boat decks so ends this day

Dec 29th

Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & strong North by wind hands employed in various jobs boat decks mid & latter parts calm got a fore yard from shore to day sent down the old one & sawd it into so ends this day

Dec 30th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & westerly wind hands employed fitting fore yard mid & latter parts weather much the same sent up fore yard to day so ends

Dec 31st

Sunday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & variable wind hands employed in various jobs boat decks mid & latter parts calm John Brass & C^o R. Key holds deserted from the ship during the night so ends this day

Jan 1st

Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & strong breeze from the North red mid & latter parts variable winds hands employed boat decks so ends this day

Jan 2nd

Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & N W wind mid & latter parts the same took 100 bbls water on board today from a water. Boat so ends this day

Jan 3rd

Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & fresh breeze from S E employed repairing fore sail mid & latter parts the same so ends this day

Jan 4th

Thursday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & N E wind hands employed repairing fore & sail on sail on latter parts cloudy so ends this day

Jan 5th

Friday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather with frequent rain squalls mid part the same latter part fine weather so ends

Jan 6th

Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & N E wind mid & latter parts showery took on board 3 tan Bread 12 ton Flour Potatoes & other stores so ends this day
