and better weather so ends this day. Robert left came on duty to day

June 26th
Tuesday. First of these 24 hours strong. S.W. wind hands
employed rafting and stowing water mid & latter
parts strong S.W. so ends this day

June 27th
Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.W. wind
wind got of provisions to day from shore & stowed
it down mid & latter parts fine weather got off. Potatoes
and small stores to day. Antone. Penner remains the same
