July 17th
 Tuesday First of these 24 hours fine weather light Easterly wind. R R steering by the wind saw 2 Fin backs mid & latter parts. S E wind lighted Boat. Island this morning at 10. Am raised Sunday Island so ends this day Lat 29.52 Long 178.34 W

July 18th
 Wednesday First of these 24 hours fresh breeze from S E. R R steering N. W. E at dark Sunday Island in sight bearing E. N. E 40 miles mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 28.31 Long 177.57 W

July 19th
 Thursday First of these 24 hours light S. E. wind by winds mid & latter parts out ms so ends this day Lat 28.06 Long 177.07 W

July 20th
 Friday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable wind. R R steering N. E by the wind saw 2 Fin backs to day mid & latter parts fine weather raised 1 sperm whale at 7. Am lowered for them the 30. R went on & got it over but did not get fast so ends Lat 27.30 Long 175.29 W

July 21st
 Saturday First of these 24 hours fine weather & Westward by wind. Boats in chase of whales at 1 hour. Pm the 30. R went on and struck and drew after he had put out one shot line soon after the 2nd mate struck a small one killed him took him to the ship & sent him in mid & latter parts strong breeze started to boil at 4. Am so ends Lat 27.08 Long 174

July 22nd
 Sunday First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong Northward winds employed boiling mid & latter parts blowing fresh with much rain finished sailing at 8. Pm so ends this day Lat 26.84 Long 173.04 W

July 23rd
 Monday First of these 24 hours fresh breeze from S. W. R R steering N. W. W saw the California to day steering to the N. E. mid & latter parts fine weather saw 2 humpbacks bottom to day so ends this day Lat 24.45 Long 172.44 W

July 24th
 Tuesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze from the Southward. R R steering N. W. W mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 22.38 Long 172.59

July 25th
 Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze from the S. E. R R steering N. W. W mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day Lat 20.26 Long 172.10

July 26th
 Thursday First of these 24 hours fine weather & a moderate breeze from the Eastward. R R steering N. W. E saw one sail to day mid & latter parts light variable winds saw several humpbacks so ends Lat 19.01 Long 173.06

July 27th
 Friday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N. E. wind. R R steering different courses mid & latter parts light air & calm at 9. Am raised the Island of Oahu so ends this day Lat 18.32 Long 173.33

July 28th
 Saturday First of these 24 hours light S. W. wind. R R steering in for the land mid & latter parts equally employed heaving ship up to anchorage so ends this day

July 29th
 Sunday First of these 24 hours fine weather & S. E. wind came to anchor in 2 1/2 fathoms water at 5. Pm mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day

July 30th
 Monday First of these 24 hours hazy weather & S. E. wind mid & latter parts light winds lowered the S. B. & R. for whales to day saw one but did not get near him so ends this day
