

Remarks On board B. H.

Dec 24th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light. 1. E wind. Bk.
Monday steering N. & N. lost sight the Land at 2. We saw one sail
steering to N. & E. in rather weather much the same

Dec 25th we ends this day Lat 30.31 Long 166.50

Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather. N. E. wind. R. K. steering
N. W. G. R. saw 5 or 6 muskrats. Porpoises & squid to day
mid latter parts much the same as ends this day. Lat 31° 33' long 163°

Dec 26th. First of these 24 hours fine weather. Northward by wind. Bk
Hed m. day steering at N saw a sulphur bottom mid & latter parts weather
the same so ends this day Lat 31.57 Long 164.28

Dec 21st. First of these 24 hours almost weather & moderate breeze
Thursday from N.E. On steering N.W. saw gunners & Porpoises today
mid part much rain latter part clearing a gale from S.W.
and halting to the E. toward 20 miles Sat 3.2.40 Long 16.3.50

Q. 10 28th. First of these 24 hours fine weather but blowing & gale
Friday from the westward mild & latter parts strong breeze. Bk
starting by the wind under lower topsails & courses
ends this day Lat 32.23 Long 162.42

Dec 28th. First of three 24 hours fine weather and strong breeze from Saturday the windward. To Westward by the wind on Port tack under lower topsails & runs 54 gibs at 5. Pm freshened main sail 14 gibs mid & latter parts fine weather at day light made sail & ends this day Lat 32 16 Long 161 45

4 to 30th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze
Sunday from the Southward. Bk. steering by the wind heading
N. by W. under better parts light variable winds so ends this 24
Oct 32. 33. Long 16.2

Dec 31st 4th of the 4 hours fine weather & light Easterly wind
Monday. Bk steering N by E at dark shortened sail mid & tops parts
fine weather saw 3 promineas & 4 Porpoises to depends thing
Jan 1st Lat 33.08 Long 160.45

18 June 1894. First of the 24 hours fine weather & light. Northerly
wind. R. & steering & by 8 employed repairing sails
craft. Masker & myself had a little misunderstanding
today and some hard words passed between us. I
went below and went after a while but went to work again
after supper mid & latter part weather the same & ends the day
better & 24 hours fine

Thursday by the wind on star board tack under lower topsails exasperated got at
dark shortened sail mid & latter parts fine weather & ends

June 7th First 24 hours. Northward by wind with heavy fog. Br. has
Monday's wind & rather poor but same winds this day sat 31.32 Sun 16056

and 8th. Wind at the 24 hours thick foggy weather strong
Tuesday. Northwardly wind. What sailing at 5 P.M. shortened
sail & lifted to the wind on Port back mid & latter part
thick fog so ends this day. no P.M.

just 2nd. Wind of these 24 hours blowing fresh from S. with min.
 Wednesday at 3. PM weather cleared up, and sail steering to
 the Eastward with better pure fine weather at daylight
 made sail so ends this day Lat. 38.08 Long. 161.56

Jan 10th. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light westerly
Thursday wind. Bk steering by the wind on Port tack with
partly strong breeze saw one sunfish & 2000 birds at 3 P.M. 1850

Jan 11th First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N.W. wind
Friday P.M. steering by the wind on Port tack at 10 A.M. started
sail and latter part fine weather & light N.W. wind & light
wind P.M. steering. Wind backed to the Eastward
to 10 o'clock & so on this day
