

Remarks on board. R. H. R. Morrison 1884

- May 23rd Friday. First of these 24 hours heavy weather & E wind. R. H. under all sail steering by the wind on. Part tack mid & latter parts fine weather employed repairing. Sparker so ends this day Lat 29.10 Long 168.05
- May 24th Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind. R. H. steering by the wind on. Part tack ~~so ends this day~~ Lat ~~29.10~~ Long ~~168.05~~
- Lat in sight all day also sawd sail mid & latter parts strong. NE wind saw several. Fin backs so ends this day Lat 29.56 Long 167.34
- May 25th Sunday. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from Sunday. Lat 30.13. Pm took in fore top sail & fore sail saw Fin backs & Porpoises mid & latter parts blowing & gale at 2 hours. Am wind shifted to westward and moderated some so ends this day Lat 30.13 Long 168.19
- May 26th Monday. First of these 24 hours strong westerly wind. R. H. steering by the wind under short sail mid & latter parts variable winds with passing showers employed repairing. Main sail saw plenty of. Fin backs to day so ends this day Lat 29.35 Long 168.05
- May 27th Tuesday. First of these 24 hours weather more moderate. R. H. finished & bent main sail at 3 Pm raised the anchor also sawd sail mid & latter parts fine weather. Manned. A Charts off duty sick so ends this day Lat 28.38 Long 167.51
- May 28th Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & S. E. wind. R. H. steering by the wind on. Fin back & a piece of squid mid & latter part strong breeze. Manned. A Charts off duty sick so ends this day Lat 29.14 Long 167.03

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- May 29th Thursday. First of these 24 hours strong E wind. R. H. laying to under Main top sail & stay sails mid & latter parts fine weather employed in various jobs about decks & in the rigging so ends this day Lat 30.13 Long 166.33
- May 30th Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & E wind. R. H. steering by the wind on. Part tack saw several Fin backs to day at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts strong breeze so ends this day Lat 29.5 Long 166.73
- May 31st Saturday. First of these 24 hours strong E wind. R. H. steering by the wind on. Part tack saw Fin backs at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts strong breeze saw several pieces of squid so ends this day Lat 29.19 Long 167.13
- June 1st Sunday. First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind. R. H. steering by the wind on. Part tack at night shortened sail mid & latter parts blowing fresh at 1 Pm furled fore top sail & wore ship so ends this day Lat 29.24 Long 166.34
- June 2nd Monday. First of these 24 hours clear weather & a strong breeze from E. N. E. R. H. laying to under Main top sail & stay sails mid & latter parts fine weather at daylight made sail so ends this day Lat 29.53 Long 166.05
- June 3rd Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & N. E. wind. R. H. steering by the wind on. Part tack employed repairing sails mid & latter parts fine weather repaired main top sail to day saw a. Fin steering to the westward so ends this day Lat 30.13 Long 166.46
- June 4th Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N. E. wind. R. H. steering by the wind on. Part tack shortened sail mid & latter parts variable winds & much rain saw a sail steering to the S. E. third so ends this day Lat 29.53 Long 167.50
