June 17th Monday. First of these 24 hours flowing sea in squalls with much rain at 3. Pm wind shifted to W & blew hard for a short time & then moderated a mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends the day Lat 29.05

June 18th Tuesday. First of these 24 hours strong N.W. wind

Wednesday. B.H. lying to on. Part tack mid & latter parts the same so ends this day Lat 28.33 Long 169.21

June 19th Thursday. First of these 24 hours strong westerly wind

Friday. B.H. lying to on. Part tack mid & latter parts the same so ends this day Lat 28.06 Long 169.38

June 20th Saturday. First of these 24 hours strong S.W. wind & clear weather

Sunday. B.H. lying to on. Part to ch at night weather moderated mid part fine weather latter part equally saw Porpoises & Finbacks so ends this day

Lat 28.06 Long 170.18

June 21st Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light

Wednesday. westerly wind. B.H. steering by the wind heading to the Southward mid & latter part light air saw several Finbacks & Porpoises so ends this day

June 22nd Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light S.W. wind. B.H. under all sail steering W.S.W.

at dark shortened sail mid & latter part cloudy saw plenty of Finbacks to day so ends this day

Lat 28.45 Long 168.56

June 23rd Friday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong

Monday. Easterly wind. B.H. steering W.S.W. slighted. P.M. at 4. Pm rit a head at dark shortened

sail & luffed to the wind mid & latter parts fine weather at day lite wore ship & made sail saw Finbacks so ends this day

Lat 28.22 Long 168.28

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June 24th Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.W. wind

B.H. steering by the wind on. Part tack saw Finbacks & plenty of Birds also saw the land at dark shortened sail mid & latter parts fine

weather saw a hump back to day so ends this day

June 25th Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & variable

Wednesday wind. B.H. steering by the wind on different

tacks. Buffalo. Biff off duty back at dark shortened sail land bearing 40 miles

distant mid & latter parts strong breeze from the Southward saw several Finbacks to day

so ends this day Lat 28.12 Long 168.39

June 26th Thursday. First of these 24 hours strong Southward by

Thursday wind with heavy squalls at 2. Pm took in upper topsails & V. Main sail mid & latter parts

weather much the same at day lite wore ship & headed to the Southward so ends this day Lat 27.50 Long 169.00

June 27th Friday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & Easterly

wind. B.H. steering by the wind on. Part tack saw Finbacks mid & latter parts light variable wind. B.H. steering different courses so ends this day

Lat 28.18 Long 168.48

June 28th Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light

Saturday. N.E. wind. B.H. steering S.W. by S saw several

Finbacks mid & latter parts strong breeze from N.W. at 4. Am layed a back at day lite rained. Norfolk

Island off lee beam kept off for it and sent boat on shore Capt. Weather came off for a few things then went on shore again said was feeling some better
