June 29th Sunday. First of these 24 hours thick weather
 & Westerly wind. Bk laying off soon.
 Boat came off at 4 Pm with 6 Bogs
 Potatoes wobb ship & stood off shore
 at dark blowing fresh from S.W. with
 rain took in sail down to lower topsails
 & foresail mid & latter parts better weather made
 more sail and at 9 Am wore ship & stood in to
 the land so ends this day Lat 29.28 Long 162.51
 June 30th Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & S.W.
 wind. Bk laying off & on. Am sent
 boat on shore for Potatoes Lat 29.07 Long 163.04
 July 1st Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light
 variable wind. Bk laying off & on
 mid & latter parts the same so ends this day
 July 2nd Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & variable
 wind. Bk got off 2. Boat loads of Potatoes at dark
 stood off shore mid & latter parts squally
 at 8 Pm carried away the old gib sent in what
 was left of it at 10 Am sent a boat ashore
 for the Capt so ends this day
 July 3rd Thursday. First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind
 ship carrying sail hard trying to hold up
 at 2 Pm Boat came off with the Capt kept
 ship off. N.W.W. saw a number of Cormorants
 mid & latter parts weather much the same
 so ends this day Lat 29.02 Long 162.34
 July 4th Friday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong
 Easterly wind with passing showers. Bk steering
 N.W.W. mid & latter parts weather much the same
 so ends this day Lat 29.15 Long 166.36

July 5th Saturday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & N.E.
 wind. Bk steering N.W. saw a Finback
 mid & latter parts cloudy weather & strong Easterly
 winds so ends this day Lat 29.36 Long 167.56
 July 6th Sunday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong
 Easterly wind. Bk steering N.W. mid & latter
 parts the same saw several Cormorants during the day
 going quick to the northward so ends this day
 Lat 29.49 Long 163.10 E.
 July 7th Monday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & moderate
 breeze from the Eastward. Bk steering N.W. under
 all sail mid & latter parts weather much the
 same so ends this day Lat 29.20 Long 161.58
 July 8th Tuesday. First of these 24 hours Easterly wind & equally
 at 4 Pm took in upper topsails & courses
 at dark took in all sail but lower main topsail
 & luffed to the wind on Starboard tack mid & latter
 parts weather the same at 8 Am kept ship off
 so ends this day no obs
 July 9th Wednesday. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from the
 Eastward with much rain. Bk steering N.W. by S
 at 4 Pm wore ship to on Starboard tack
 mid & latter parts weather much the same
 so ends this day Lat 29.48 Long 160.20
 July 10th Thursday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather strong
 Easterly wind with passing showers. Bk
 steering N.W. by S. mid & latter parts weather much
 the same at 3 Am layed aback till day lite
 after day lite kept off on her course so ends
 Lat 29.53
