

Remarks on board. B K

- Aug 23rd Saturday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong E wind mid & latter parts much the same so ends this day
- Aug 24th Sunday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong E wind mid & latter parts the same so ends this day
- Aug 25th Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & strong breeze from E & E mid & latter parts weather much the same lowered 3 Boats this morning so ends this day
- Aug 26th Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & E wind 2nd mate struck & killed him & took him to the ship. mid & latter parts fine weather lowered 4 Boats to day so ends this day
- Aug 27th Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind. Wednesday arrived out our whale in the afternoon. mid & latter parts variable wind with rain lowered 3 Boats to day so ends this day
- Aug 28th Thursday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind Boats got on board at 3 Pm with Eggs mid & latter parts fine weather lowered 4 Boats to day the 2nd mate struck & killed him to spouting blood then got his boat at stove by a loose whale the Capt struck the whale soon after and turned her up. the 2nd mate of the Triton assisted our 2nd mate until one of our Boats got to him so ends this day
- Aug 29th Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze from the Eastward got our whale to the ship at 4 Pm then sent 2 Boats to help the Tritons. Boats towed on to them & while towing the whale sank & took Capt Childs Boat and every thing belonging to it down our Boats got to the ship at 8 Pm. mid & latter parts light variable wind & rain cut in our whale today also lowered 2 Boats so ends this day

- Aug 30th Saturday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind finished cutting at 4 Pm. Boats got on board at 5 mid parts cloudy weather later parts fine weather lowered 3 Boats to day saw plenty of whales 2nd mate darted at one but did not get fastened
- Aug 31st Sunday. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong Easterly wind. Boats got on board at 5 Pm employed boiling mid & latter parts fine weather finished boiling at 5 Am. 3rd mate came on duty to day so ends this day
- Sept 1st Monday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light E wind mid part raining latter parts fine weather lowered 3 Boats to day but the 3rd mate came on board again his Boat leaked so so ends this day
- Sept 2nd Tuesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind the 2nd mate struck & killed & the lower parted employed towing down. Boats came on board at half past 5 Pm mid & latter parts fine weather lowered 4 Boats to day for whales so ends this day
- Sept 3rd Wednesday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind. Boats got on board at 5 Pm mid & latter parts fine weather lowered 4 Boats to day the Capt got a Cow with a calf so ends this day
- Sept 4th Thursday. First of these 24 hours strong Easterly wind. Thursday tried to tow our whale to the ship but could not make much head way so got under weigh with the ship & ran down to the whale & anchored got the whale alongside at 6 Pm mid & latter parts strong winds did not lower to day cut in our whale so ends this day
- Sept 5th Friday. First of these 24 hours blowing fresh from the East employed scraping bones & doing other jobs got ready to boil at 6 Pm mid & latter parts strong breeze did not lower to day so ends this day
