Monday First of these 24 hours fine weather & light variable winds. mid & latter parts the same. Capt went on shore to day. Mr. Semas was. Paid off to day so ends this day

Oct 19th First of these 24 hours strong southerly wind

Sunday mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day

Oct 20th First of these 24 hours fine weather & southerly

Monday wind mid & latter parts weather the same so ends this day

Oct 21st First of these 24 hours strong & variable winds

Tuesday employed in various jobs mid & latter parts same weather so ends this day

Oct 22nd First of these 24 hours heavy squalls of wind & rain

Wednesday from different points at 3 P.M. dropped 2nd anchor mid part weather much the same latter part fine weather

took up our 2nd anchor this morning so ends this day

Oct 23rd First of these 24 hours fine weather & fresh breeze from

Thursday the westward hands employed in various jobs boat decks mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day

Oct 24th First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & N.W. winds

Friday employed in various jobs boat decks. mid & latter parts raining so ends this day

Oct 25th First of these 24 hours weather more moderate not

Saturday much going on boat decks mid & latter parts fine weather employed breaking out me at so ends this day

Oct 26th First of these 24 hours fine weather & southerly

Sunday winds mid & latter parts weather the same so ends

Oct 27th First of these 24 hours fine weather & variable winds to day

Monday night wind breeze S.W. from S.W. mid & latter parts fine weather so ends this day

Oct 28th First of these 24 hours fine weather & southerly wind

Tuesday mid & latter parts the same took on shore 8 kegs of spermaceti contained about 10 1/2 lbs which has been sold so ends this day. Captain had Mr. Sawyer off to look at the ship & was on shore at the time with the oil

Wednesday First of these 24 hours fine weather & westerly wind employed washing. Bone mid & latter parts strong breeze so ends this day

Oct 30th First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & strong southerly

Thursday wind employed washing. Bone at 2 P.M. dropped 2nd anchor mid & latter parts weather much the same so ends this day

Oct 31st First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & southerly wind

Friday found led air Bone to day there are 10 bbls containing 1 & 29 lbs since yesterday found more. Bone bled 10.3 lbs

commenced this morning and ran the salt water out of

ground tier and took the cash on deck also broke the coal out

for peak so ends this day

Nov 1st First of these 24 hours cloudy weather employed pumping

Saturday water out of hold at 4 P.M. sent boat on shore after Capt mid & latter parts raining weather so ends this day

Nov 2nd First of these 24 hours thick raining weather & southerly wind

Sunday Capt went on shore at 2 P.M. mid & latter parts strong winds

Nov 3rd First of these 24 hours strong southerly wind part of the men

Monday on shore to day came on board at 5 P.M. mid & latter parts squally so ends this day

Nov 4th First of these 24 hours fine weather at 4 P.M.

Tuesday three men came on board to examine the ship looked round the ship and bored in to their own

places came on board looked round some then

went between decks in main hatch and latter

parts fine weather sent on shore 3 kegs. Bone containing 1 & 3 lbs so ends this day

Nov 5th First of these 24 hours fine weather & easterly winds

Wednesday I went on shore to day returned at 5 P.M. mid & latter

parts fine weather unbent all the sails so ends
