

# Remarks on board Ship

Dec 12<sup>th</sup>

Friday. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze from E. N.E. Ship under all sail steering by the wind on. Port tack mid & latter parts equally weather at 2 A.M. fired. Royal 20 ends this day Lat 34.17 Long 164.17

Dec 13<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours thick rainy weather & N.E. wind Ship. Saturday steering by the wind on. Port tack mid & latter parts weather better than this day Lat 34.29 Long 163.55 E

Dec 14<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours fine weather & N. wind Ship steering E. N.E. under Sunday all sail mid & latter parts weather much the same as ends this day

Dec 15<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours thick foggy weather & light North by winds. Monday Ship steering by the wind heading E. N.E. & at 2 P.M. steering to the westward mid & latter parts weather much the same as ends this day Lat 33.18 Long 162.51 E

Dec 16<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light N.E. wind Ship. Tuesday steering by the wind on. Port tack mid & latter parts much the same as ends this day Lat 33.30 Long 163.03

Dec 17<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather at this & strong breeze. Wednesday off from the N. Ship steering E. by N. W. at 10 P.M. saw a sail steering to westward mid & latter parts weather much the same as ends this day Lat 33.30 Long 164.38 E

Dec 18<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & North by wind Ship. Thursday steering E. by N. W. mid & latter parts light winds at 8 A.M. wind shifted to the westward as ends this day Lat 33.21 Long 164.18

Dec 18<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light wind from the N. Thursday westward Ship steering E. N.E. mid & latter parts calm as ends Lat 33.11 Long 163.12 W

Dec 19<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours fine weather & calm hands busy. Friday employed boat deck & in the rigging mid & latter parts strong breeze as ends this day Lat by account 33.20 Long 164.42

Dec 20<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours strong breeze from the N. Ship. Saturday steering by the wind on Port tack mid & latter parts strong breeze with much rain shortened sail but set it again at 4 P.M. as ends Lat 33.28 Long 165.49

Dec 21<sup>st</sup>

Sunday. First of these 24 hours strong North by wind & cloudy weather Ship under all sail steering by the wind mid & latter parts he of squalls of wind & rain took in light sails as ends this day Lat 33.51 Long 169.32

Dec 22<sup>nd</sup>. First of these 24 hours weather more moderate made all. Monday sail on Ship mid part much the same latter part light air as ends this day Lat 33.46 Long 168.08

Dec 23<sup>rd</sup>. First of these 24 hours fine weather & light air from S. & Tuesday Ship steering E. N.E. employed & evening new fore & galant clewls mid & latter parts weather fine with a good breeze from S. & as ends this day

Dec 24<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours fine weather & S. wind Ship. Wednesday steering E. N.E. under all sail mid & latter parts baffling winds as ends this day Lat 22.10 Long 164.27

Dec 25<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze from the S. Thursday Ship steering by the wind on & at 6 A.M. took mid & latter parts fine weather as ends Lat 29.32 Long 164.15

Dec 26<sup>th</sup>. This day began with cloudy weather & variable winds. Friday variously employed boat deck as ends this day Lat 28.28 Long 164.08

Dec 27<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours cloudy weather & baffling winds. Saturday Ship steering by the wind on different tacks mid & latter parts weather much the same as ends Lat 28.22 Long 163.51

Dec 28<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours variable winds & passing showers Ship. Sunday steering by the wind under all sail mid parts the same latter part fine weather as ends this day Lat 28.14 Long 163.19

Dec 29<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours fine weather & a fresh breeze from S. & Monday Ship steering by the wind heading to the Northward mid & latter parts weather much the same as ends this day

Dec 30<sup>th</sup>. First of these 24 hours fine weather & Easterly wind Ship steering by the wind on starboard tack mid & latter parts the same at daylight sighted the Island of Patabonga as ends this day Lat 21.06 Long 160.05
