at 6 AM raised spinn. whales weather bore going
leeward lowered two boats last struck sounded over
two lines men broke

lowered the other boat struck, saved one at once got
him along side large whales some went be-^{hind} some ^{ahead}

Friday 20 some rain commenced clearing at night
hauled the whale out 14 fathoms middle light air
from NW latter calm cloudy some rain at 4 AM commen-
cing got the head off body in two sail in site

Saturday 21st comes in calm cut in the front
and having no heavy case rope they new 3 inch cordage
good hung some true parted lost, two sail in site
cleared up decks putting junk in tanks put ship under
double reef at 3 AM started fire light breeze from NW room
some rain employed boiling heading by WNW

Sunday 22nd comes in moderate breeze cloudy
employed boiling heading NW wind SW by W middle calm
baffles latter pleasant wind SW by S steering by W by N
saw two sail steering W one school porpoises employed
boiling finished body at 12 AM

Lat 43.16 Long 31.58

Monday 23rd fair pleasant employed upon
the head night shortened sail 2 reef D, 7D heading WNW
run under fair weather at 12 PM finished boiling heading NW
at 10 AM steered off E by S Lat 43.22 Long 31.46

Tuesday 24 fair pleasant steering E by S
wind SW at night shortened sail star tack remained fair
latter stowed down the oil heading NW wind W
