W SW steering by N^w Stowed off cleared up decks
& saw one sail at night shortened sail some rain
was heading ~~stayed~~ remainder strong wind squally rain
wind shifted to North so ends lying to Lat 43 31
Long 31.23

Thursday 26 comes in strong wind from N^w
heading WNW at 2 PM wore ship E^w
at P.M. 5 spoke ship Florida Little 36 days th 
heard from Barkly 30 fms on board, rem part fresh
breezes raged steered latter by heading N NW the ship
in site Lat 43 34 Long 30 19

Friday 27 strong wind raged under reef
I S courses heading E by N two whalers in site
remainder raged steering by N^e wind N^e
Lat 44 28 Long 29 37

Saturday 28 strong winds raged wore
ship steered W^e by saw two sail and two more middle
and latter raged strong breezes steering S by E westward
saw B F & Porpoises Lat 43.10
Long 29.38

Sunday 29th comes in fresh breezes raged
steering by W^e wind from NW under reef 2, 6, 7
at sunset wore ship headed NE rem of the day
Lat 44 02 Long 28 10

Monday 30th pleasant saw porpoises
two sail wind NW heading NE by the wind
middle light air calm morn. wind from NW
steering by W^e saw porpoises employed setting up
shooks  m Obs

Tuesday July 1st 1851
comes in fresh breezes from the S W B F
lowered boats all struck saved one saw one
sail steering N E by E night shortened sail to double
reef 2, 4, 5 heading NW W, remainder of the day
strong wind from SW steering by N^e saw two sail
Lat 44.15 Long 31.23

Wednesday 2nd
comes in strong wind from SW heading W by S
saw one sail night hoisted under double reef 3, night put
ship too steady 18 hours calm strong wind latter (saw a sail)
under 3, 5, 6 No Long by 11, Lat 44.00 Long 32 30
at 3 P.M.
