Monday July 14 comes in pleasant light air

Middle calm at 5 PM spoke ship Scotland Smith
4 days down seen calm saw B^Kish Grampus
the ship near by

Tuesday 15th comes in calm the ship near
by saw Grampus night steered SW by W light air
from N^W moon pleasant between the hours of
five and six AM

Wednesday 16th comes in light winds
pleasant steering SWⁿ saw grampuses
middle pleasant between the hours of five and
six AM heard an outcry in the Forecastle the
most of the Barks crew being upon deck at the time
when my first Officer went immediately forward
and was met by Franklin Vincents coming out
of the Fore castle ~~by~~ immediate investigation
found that he had cut or stabbed Edwin Hall
three times in the face he was called and put
said Franklin in Irons and dressed the wounds
of him part of the day fair pleasant

Thursday 17th comes in and out calm

L. Vincent in Irons saw plenty grampus
so early
