Lat-36.52 Long 35.05
Monday 21st of July 1851
comes in pleasant steering W
wind NNE strong wind a few hours latter
pleasant saw a large squid & 7 confound

light N air calm saw ~~several~~ porpoises
at 9 Am got a Lunar Obs heading W
(J. Vincent's confirmed) Lat 36.35

Long by Redding 7' Chron at 4 Pm 38.02
by Lunar 6 hours prior 37.43

Wednesday 23 calm light air heading W
saw B. got one at 9 Am took a Lunar Obs 0 Pm
giving Greenwich time 23. 45.45

" ship time 21. 13.31 = long 38.03
by Chron at 4 Pm following 38.04
by add 7' min. to Chron.

Thursday 24 light breeze from NW steering
by NE rem light varying N winds at 6
Ex signalled & long with an Eng ship which agreed
it two more in sight Lat 37.00
Chron - Long 38.04
