

Thursday 11th September 1851
comes in strong wind from ENE
steering by SE at 6 PM tacked to the N
night. Shortened sail saw one sail to windward
remainder pleasant, wind from ESE steering
in by the wind for Teceira was spoken by
Bark Black Eagle of Sagharbour, ^{day} clean
saw several sail

Thursday 12th
light breeze from ESE Angra City bearing
at 4 PM N by E dis 14 miles Chrs, and error
correct night shortened sail SW remainder fair
saw two sail heading ESE wind South

Friday 13th
fair pleasant Teceira bearing NW dis
about 20 miles passed a Por Boat steering for
Teceira rem pleasant heading ESE wind NW
so ends this day

Saturday 14th comes in pleasant
wind South steering by E. Latter heading
SE middle and latter pleasant saw Grampian
Lat 38.34
Long 25.06

Sunday 15th
comes in pleasant saw Grampian
one sail at 4 PM heading ESE tacked wind blowing
Sunset heading W shortened sail latter heading
ESE had a squall, of rain lightning thunder &
on sail in sight

Monday 16th
some light rain first chews pleasant sun first
sunset wind SW heading SSE light air at 4 PM
1st St Michaels bore by Capt. W. dis SE. 15 1/2, middle
and latter light air from NW steering by E

Tuesday 17th
comes in pleasant saw the 1st St Marys at 12 1/2
bore W & sunset W & W middle part blowing wind light
air with lightning latter steering S. wind NW moderate
some shower of rain cloudy
