Thursday 18th
 comes in pleasant saw finback
 one sail at night left too W^W wind N^W
 latter some rain showed steering S^W saw two sail
 Lat 34. 48

Friday 19th
 comes in light air can plenty of showers
 signalled on Eng Brig sunset calm whaling bark
 3 miles NW middle calm latter N^W wind
 now spoke bark Dr Franklin of no class
 latter steered off W^{SW} Lat 34. 16
 Lat 20 Long 22. 46

comes in pleasant employed feting again
 at sunset saw a sail seen several rain squalls
 do endy Lat 33. 00 Long 23. 40

Sunday 21st
 comes in fair baffling breezes from E^W steering
 by the saw 8 sail at one time signalled a Hunting
 Brig round stern at night double reefed some fine
 breeze from ESE varying several points saw several
 sail N^W Lat 31. 48
 Long 23. 10

Monday 22nd E. 2. 20
 comes in pleasant some light showers of rain
 steering S^W by at sunset (passed a French Brig
 having four masts on two masts) double reefed
 heading S middle and latter squalling strong
 wind from ESE

Lat 31. 49
 Tuesday 23rd
 comes in pleasant breeze some light
 rain seen - pleasant saw two sail one bar
 one whaler saw a finback &c Lat 29. 45
 Long 23. 47
