comes in light ENE wind steering S by W pleasant saw one sail a ship steering SW^{ly} plenty porpoises employed stowing down finished washed off at 5 PM at sunset shortened sail tack ship N^{ly} wind N^{ly} morn tack E W ESE saw signalize Brazilian Brig steering S by E so ends

Wednesday 26th comes in fresh breeze from ENE steering by SE^{ly} middle and latter on opposite tacks at 5 PM spot ship barkley of NB Jaber 18 moth spoken first part of the 24th

Thursday 27

strong wind from NE employed setting up even - shirks & at 4 spoke as above had seen about her latter strong NW^{ly} wind varying the ship in site

Lat 32. 32

Long 49. 17

Friday 28th

strong NE wind raged saw a bark steering S^{ly} green porpoises ^{by barkley} porpoises passed a Brazilian Brig seen raged (the ship 6 to windward) on opposite tacks
