rainy blowing strong barometer 29.75 at 10 shift wind

Sunday 30th
comes in with a shift of wind to NW
steered of N by W then NW West through
the night wind moderated latter NW saw
a ship steering by S by W wind SW wind increased
Lat 32 16
Long 48 48

Monday 1st these 24 hours comes in fresh
breezes from SW course NW 2 P.M. took in M.S.D. double reefed
at 3 took in jib close reefed 3.30 left two heading NW NW middle
and latter moderate wind NW cruising Lat 31 30
Long 48 45

Tuesday 2 comes in pleasant
steering NW wind SW saw porpoises considerable
swell from S. at sunset wore ship heading S by E. saw a
Morphedite Brig working Sth middle and latter light
air from NW heading Eth saw porpoises & one
sail Lat 31.22
Long 48 36

Wednesday 3rd comes in pleasant
breeze from S by steering by Eth saw killas porpoises
Simon fish remainder pleasant at 6 P.M. tacked heading
W saw humpback finback killas porpoises & two sail
merchantmen 30 steamers hump back on the wind NW
Lat 31.36
Long 48 38
