Friday 12th comes in fresh breezes from NNE by compass wore ship NW^{ly} saw porpoises at sunset saw a sail at 9 PM passed a ship sailing supposed the Barkley morn kept of NW at 8 combel water kept of S by E so ends Mer Lat 33.23
 Long Mer - 49.16

Sat 13th comes in pleasant wind ENE heading SE by the wind middle part heading NW^{ly} latter SE & saw a sail, thick damp weather morning from boats. No Mer Lat
 4 PM Long 49.24

Sunday 14th thick some light rain cloudy see about 2 miles dis at 4 PM spoke ship Barkley 25th since seen rem. - on opposite tack thick weather morn - saw the Barkley & no obs

Monday 15th comes in thick wind NE steering by SE commenced cooler water saw several Merchantmen - steering NW one sail in site at 1 PM middle part heading SE^{ly} latter NW strong wind saw plenty porpoises - Lat 33.15 Long 49.30 at 4 PM following
 Tuesday 16th comes in fresh breezes from NE steering by NW under double reef 3rd jib. 4th Spanker, at one PM saw sup^r the Barkley to leeward at 2 came into thick water full of bright blue specks and small manowar, at sunset wore ship middle part strong winds latter light winds rainy fog on opposite tacks wind NNE no observation

Wednesday 17 comes thick weather rain heading east by the wind middle part moderate latter at 9 AM tacked to NW. pleasant Lat 33.36 Long 48.58
 Thursday 18th comes in pleasant steering by the wind NW wind NNE moderate all sail set middle and latter strong wind from ENE steering by N^{ly} passed a French Brig so ends this day Lat 32.51 Long 49.25

Friday 19th comes in strong wind at 2 PM wore ship SE middle part on opposite tacks latter heading E wind NNE strong squally so ends this day Lat 33.20 Long 49.13
