N^o by E^o under E^o & reef M^o, close reef 9^o night
left to N^o saw porpoises rem about the same
laying to no Obs saw porpoises finback
Friday 16

comes in strong WSW wind rugged day
steering N^o by night laying to latter fair weather
saw finbacks porpoises, Lat 36, 35 Long 47.58

Saturday 17

comes in fair light winds steering N^o saw a
big herring bot^o - night left to S^o, rem under
pleasant latter steered S^o saw Grampuses porpoises
repaired the mainsail Lat 36, 45 Long 46.7

Sunday 18

comes in light W^o wind steering N^o saw
porpoises & one merchant brig steering N^o
middle and latter light winds steering N^o &
saw porpoises Grampuses & Lat 35.33. Long 44.67

River La Platte for Spinn
Monday 19th

comes in pleasant steering N^o by E^o by a
wind S^o W^o some cloudy 4^o m course N, middle
wind parted to S^o remainder steered N^o saw Grampuses
plenty latter fresh breeze Lat 33.44 Long 44.95 -
Tuesday 20th

these 24 hours comes in pleasant, wind from E^o & E
steering N^o by E^o night shortened sail left to heading N^o &
middle and latter pleasant wind from NE saw
Grampuses at 4.40 spoke ship Garland 65^o Lat 32.57 Long 44.16

Wednesday 21st

comes in pleasant steering W to ship in 8^o night
shortened sail heading S^o, remainder part wind coming
from NE to WSW the (ship in site S^o) steering N^o by E^o
saw Grampuses porpoises & - to ends Lat 31.44 Long 45.1

Thursday 22

comes in pleasant, wind from SW steering N
night shortened sail left to N^o, remainder plain
steering by N^o W^o some cloudy Lat 30.18 Long 45.51
