Friday Jan 23

comes in pleasant light wind from S.E. steering W.S.W. middle on opposite tack latter steered to saw porpoises Lat 30.30 Long 47.10

Saturday 24th

comes in fair smoky steering W saw Gumpus night shortened sail wind N.E. heading S.E. by E at 12 P.M. wore ship remainder steering westward saw Gumpus at end this day Lat 30.30 Lat Long 48.38

Sunday 25th

comes in fresh breezes from N.E. steering W. night wore ship shortened sail latter steered S.W. wind strong from N.E. so ends Lat 31.00 Long 48.57

Monday 26th

comes in fresh winds steering S.E. saw porpoises middle and latter fair pleasant steering by N.E. saw Gumpus wind E.N.E. so ends this day Lat 32.50 Long 48.3

Tuesday 27th

comes in pleasant saw a ship steering N.W. at sunset and wind E.N.E. heading N.W. middle and latter strong N.E. wind steering N.W. saw a French Bark heading N.W. Lat 31.58 Long 49.4

Wednesday 28th

comes in strong N.E. wind steering by N.W. saw a brig steering S. at sunset wore ship to S.E. shortened sail, middle and latter strong breezes from N.W. Lat 32.00 Long 49.20

Thursday 29th

these 24 hours comes in strong N. wind steering by W. at 5 P.M. squall of rain wind shifted to S.W. sunset close reef 4s. heading W. at 11 wore ship middle squally raged at 8 A.M. kept E.N.E. under (last reef 4.7.8 4.8 double reef 4.7.8 4.8) (Long 49.06 at 8 A.M.) middle and latter moderate wind N.W. steering E. no ~~the~~ Lat, D.R. 31.30 Long 48.21

Friday 30th

comes in pleasant at 11 P.M. wore ship headed S.W. latter pleasant steering W. R. post & saw a ship at sunset for it (saw pillars) at 11 saw ship again N.W. by W. remainder part pleasant

Saturday 31st

comes in pleasant steering W. saw eight wind from E
