Sunday February 1st 1852

comes in light winds from E and
W. saw Grampus Lat 31.19 Long 47.36

Monday 2

comes in pleasant steering WNW saw
one sail W. steering South, middle and latter
pleasant latter steering WNW saw killer & repairing
Gresail Mes Lat 32.4 Long 48.49.37

Tuesday 3rd

these 4 hours comes in pleasant steering by S. 4
PM left to NW wind NE at sunset were ship head
8.22.24 saw pleasant latter steering by E Lat 33 Long 48.63

Wednesday 4

comes in pleasant steering by E wind NE by N
at sunset tacked NW, latter smother at 11 AM
saw two large sperm whales going very quick to NW by N.
latter two boats did not get up with them saw
two visings in Lat 33.12 Long 49.28

Thursday 5th

comes in pleasant some smoky boats off at 8
came on board standing W at 2 PM tacked heading
NE by E day light wore ship steering W by the wind saw
Grampus & on ends this day Lat 33.12 Long 49.19

Friday 6th

comes in pleasant wind from NW steering by westward
morning several sail in sight plenty Grampuses
latter steered by E wind from NW by N Lat 33.36 Long 49.25

Saturday 7th

comes in pleasant saw several sail considerable
smoky steering by heading NE by E middle and a sail
latter steered W by the wind ~~also~~ plenty Grampuses
Chronometer broke or something else
Long com' from the last 49.30 at 4 PM

Sunday 8th

comes in thick mist otherwise pleasant
at sunset tacked wind NW heading NE middle
light air morning wind NW 6.30 wore ship steered NE at 10 calm
baking cloudy some thunder
