Saturday 14th

comes in fair wind sailing W by N heading SE by E at 7 N by E employed boiling the Body and middle part wind veered to NW started head at 7 AM finished boiling & Lat 31. 55 Long DR 47. 13 by Lunar Obs Long 47. 55
