by E night close reef to sails heading ESE
at 10 breezed on took in 7, 8 latter some rain, moderated
and cleared wind canting to W NW Lat 32.33 Long DR 47.10

comes in light air from W SW heading NW E at 4 PM
oil ahead 2 m moderate breeze thick weather
saw Grampuses
