pleasant breeze from SW
steering NE all sail, 1/2 Students sail,
middle and latter light SW wind steering
NE set star 1/2 1/2 1/2, so end Lat 23. 53 Long 40. 59
being somewhat feeble,

Saturday 3rd
comes in light air from SW set
Lat 23. 53 1/2 at 2 PM some rain wind W & course
NE by E, some unwell go, middle fresh breeze from
SE & latter light winds SE cloudy all slowly recovering
so ends this day Lat 22. 35 Long 39. 16

Sunday 4th
comes in pleasant light air from
S steering NE by E at 4 PM, NE by E saw
one herm Brig under short sail supposed a whaler
middle and latter light wind from S.
steering NE by E saw one sail so ends
Lat 21. 10 Long 37. 34

Monday 5th comes in light wind
at 4 PM had a shift from N with rain at 7 hauled
to South again course NE by E remains light
6th wind varying saw two sail, Lat 20. 36 Long 35. 15
