

Remarks on Board Barks
April Thursday 22nd

come in 4 knot breeze from S.E. course
N.E. by N at 6 PM wind S.E. by S pleasant
fresh breeze water light air & S.E. at 4.30 P.M.
Lat 3.30 N Long 32.12 W

Friday 23rd

comes in light air from S.E. & S.W. course
N.E. by N, middle & equally rain later calm & E
air previous or 4 PM saw the ROCOS ROCKS
bearing N.E. by E 15 miles remain pleasant
breeze wind Lat 3.30 Long 32.5

Saturday 24th

comes in light air from N heading
E by the wind middle squalls of rain light
wind from N.E. steering by N.W. & calm latter calm
N.W. air steering by E Lat 3.07 Long 34.06

Sunday 25th

comes in light-W.N.W. air steering N.E. by N
one hour, being ahead steering the same middle & latter
light baffin air occurred the latter showing Portuguese flag rocks

Livingston Sound North 52
Monday 26th

comes in baffin winds S, N.E. & S comes
N.E. by N some rain cloudy middle and latter
moderate light breeze from N.W. steering by N.E.
varying a point or two Lat 2.00 S Long 32.46 W

Tuesday 27th

comes in light air from N, & N.W. steering by
S.E. pleasant nothing remarkable one sick
Lat 1.14 S Lat 4 PM 1.10 Long 31.36

Wednesday 28th

comes in pleasant heading N.E. by E
by the wind light breezes middle part heading
shows to the N.W. latter S.W. at 9 PM saw 11 small
boats struck one cutting light air from N
Lat 1.10 S Lat 4 PM 1.10 Long 30.32

Thursday 29th

light baffin air N.W. west course at 10 AM one
brig in site, middle part fresh breezes passed
the brig wind W.N.W. & W by N comes N.E. saw 8 PM
so ends this Lat 1.10 N 3 PM, Lat 53 Long 29.47 W
