Friday Apr 30 Sea Oct

comes in moderate breezes from NW
steering N by E & wing overing NW at 3. ~~4~~
NW veered back to NW, course the Brig then Eng
remain the baffin winds from N Lat 1. 18 Long 34. 25

Saturday

May 1st P.M.

comes in light winds from N steering
by NW the Brig in sight latter saw 6 sails
so in sight this day Lat 1. 59 Long about 30. 12

Sunday 2nd

comes in wind light from NE varying to E
at 6 PM set students sail course N by E, cloudy
middle rainy calm at 1 PM breeze from NE steers
by NW latter heading NW but strong wind

Trotter's

Lat 2. 47 Long 30. 42

Monday 3 comes in pleasant - several sails
in sight remain the fresh breezes veering NNE to NE by compass
one sail in sight. Lat 4. 8 Long 32. 32

Remarks May 1852,
Tuesday 4th

comes in fresh breezes from NE by N steering
by NW wind veering about 2 points middle & latter
strong breezes some light rain. Lat 5. 40 Long 34. 40

Wednesday 5th

comes in fresh wind NE steering by NW cloudy
nothing in sight at 8 PM heading NNE 4 knots
middle and latter strong wind 4 PM & 5 PM
in a short time wind NE heading about NNE
pleasant & Lat 7. 31. 4 PM, Long 35. 23

shows less 2000 strokes 6 AM Thursday 6

comes in strong trade heading NW
by the wind, wind being NE by E (compass)
at 4.30 PM pumped ship, 1500 strokes being about 150 per hour
middle and latter strong wind 4 PM in Lat 9. 40 Long 36. 33

Friday 7th

comes in strong wind heading N. filed a in 4 PM strong
pumped every 10 min or 1 hour, 150 per hour, took in 4 PM & some
dwell per etc, remainder strong wind heading N by NE
1 PM Lat 12. 02 Long 37. 54
