the appearance of land at 1 P.M. commenced working up
toward the Isl of Hayd saw firback Grouped &

Sat 29 P.M.

comes in fresh breezes from the land at 3 P.M. saw
a sail off an on Osta. at sunset spoke ship off Osta
180 since left then had 500 20 fathoms 28th Civil ac^t time

Bark Lexington at Quarantine Hayd
Saturday 29th

comes in pleasant working up into Osta harbor
at 4 past 5 A.M. dropped anchor & a boat came of ordered
under weigh and drop in quarantine which was
accomplished at 9th o'clock then at 10 P.M. in some
deceatable & at night set anchor watch pleasant
remaining port

Sunday 30th

pleasant, morning a boat came of with the
medicine & for the sick, ordered wind sails and
bedding aired which was done, latter the same. at
six P.M. two custom house officers came off & so ended

Monday 31st

comes in pleasant morning sent down
Fore & Main J.D. Mast, fited rig in & remaining
part day pleasant wind S.W. at remaining port
