pleasant steering down for Teveira wind NW at 4 PM left to N^W at 12 noon ship moving left off for Teveira East end at 11 AM off whale rock. started off NW so ends

Thursday 24

pleasant steering NE wind WNW middle on opposite tack latter wind NW steering by S^W saw finbacks wet thick in after Teveira bearing NW 15°

Friday 25

fair cloudy saw porpoises finbacks & middle and latter pleasant saw 2 sail & finbacks cruising of Angra & Praya - Is of Peceira

Saturday 26

comes in pleasant heading N^W past East end of Teveira middle and lets standing off from the Is wind NW some cloudy so ends this day 12 tacked

Sunday 27

comes in pleasant fresh breezes from NW heading WSW by the wind at 5 PM tacked North part of the Is of Peceira Is, about 3 miles, night shortened sail heading N.E. remainder fair weather North of the Is

Monday 28

these 24 hours fair weather cruising North of the Is saw finbacks and fish boats.

Tuesday 29

these 24 hours pleasant run down North side of the Is middle of the East End latter on South side saw porpoises Grampuses & finbacks so ends

Wednesday 30

pleasant calm off Angra plenty finbacks & at night spoke back President of Westport Port, some 2000 yds pleasant being of Angra Is westward &
