one steam boat so ends Lat 34. 15 Long 49. 00

by day to Sth more westerly S by E Lat 33. 18 Long 46. 06

Saturday 4th

strong wind from W S W at 10 S E by S at 4 were N one sail
in sight at night spoke Brig Leonidas of Westport
9 months 250 T, bound to the S, rem pleasant S Lat 31. 46 Long 45. 23

Sunday 5th

comes in pleasant steering S wind W W some showers of rain
saw squid and sword middle and latter pleasant wind N W
steering S W saw Grampus Lat about 31. 15 Long 45. 30
