to NW pleasant middle and last calm. Lat 31.38 Long 45.33

Wednesday 8th

these 24 begin pleasant light breeze from SW steering N
plenty porpoising, at 4 PM luff to W varying winds squally
rain saw plenty porpoises Lat 31.53 Long 45.45

Thursday 9th

fair wind N by W saw porpoises killed 1st bunch
boats without success rem. light air calm employed reef
M. sail Lat 31.53 Long 45.49

Friday 10th

pleasant baffin wind calm middle and latter heavy squalls
from SE with rain close up 2 PM, whole 3d, 2d R lat 32.00, long 46

Saturday 11th

this day com- squally at 4 PM moderated fair
middle and latter pleasant light SW wind on up luff
finished M. & 2d S & bent them Lat 31.40 Long 46.07

Sunday 12th

comes in light winds from SW to W steering by NW
& pleasant middle and latter pleasant at 2 PM took
1st wind with saw a steam boat going W. Lat 31.40 Long 46.05

Monday 13th

this day comes in pleasant steering by N, wind to
middle and latter fair, heading by the wind W
broke out after he filled 6 cask water Lat 30.40 Long 46.30

Tuesday 14th

comes in fair employed setting up main rig in
middle fair latter strong W wind steering by South
heavy swell from NW Lat 29.48 Long 47.29

Barometer at 8 PM 29.52 tenths

Wednesday 15th 8 PM

comes in blowing strong from WSW at 2 PM wore ship to the N heavy
swell from the N, at night close up 3d, pulled 3d, saw beaches, & heading NNE
middle & latter gale. Lat 30.33 Long 47.15
