

Remarks on Board Bark Lexington
Monday Oct 4th 1852

comes in strong breezes from W & W hauled
gradually N^W steering by Southwesterly 8th sail
middle light air, N^E at 2 at topmast studensail
latter fine breeze from ENE steering to by no clouds cloudy

Tuesday 5th

comes in fresh breeze from ENE veering to W
and back rainy at 2 took in sail too double reefed to
fair set all sail wind E course W by S got a lunar Obs
so ends Lat 30.19 Long 61.55.40 Lunar 56-00

Wednesday 6th

comes in fair at 2 PM light rain from SE, course W by N
light breezes, middle ~~fast~~ wind ~~SE~~ W back to SE
latter heading W by S 4th studensail wind NW &

Lat 29.50 Long 58.07

Thursday 7th

comes in pleasant painted comings & clouds
point. wind NW took in studensail &aced up
middle & last variable wind between W & N; on opposite tacks
saw a ship heading E, pleasant light breeze, Lat 29.19 Long 59.14

Homeward Bound Oct 1852
Friday 8th

comes in light NW wind pleasant start
by westward middle and last part calm wa-
ir, got a Lunar Obs. which gives Long, 60.15 (Chr 59.50

no lunar Obs Lat 28.29.10 Long 60.00

Saturday 9th

comes in fine weather wind from NE course
NW by W all sail set saw a brig steering to the NW
middle and last part light breeze from N^E so ends
pumped ship 30 strokes Lat 29.40 Long 61.13

Sunday 10th

comes in very light North Easterly wind steering
by 8 course NW by W, middle calm. latter light N wind
two sail in sight Lat 29.43 Long 61.58

Monday 11th

light Easterly wind course NW by W 18 1/2 W
middle and last the same saw several sail

Lat 30.08 Long 63.20
