

Tuesday June 14th 1841  
Light from the NW wind calms a number  
of fishing schooners in sight all hands employed  
in backing out and stowing away things Middle  
fine at 10 PM Tacked to the East at 3 AM  
to the SW Later strong Lat 34.56 Long 72.6

Friday June 15th  
Strong from the SE steering SW all hands employed  
in backing out and stowing away between decks  
Middle fine Later the same Lat 33.53 Long 72.16

Saturday June 16th  
Strong winds from the NW one sail in  
sight Middle strong Later the same

Sunday June 20th  
Light from the SW one sail in sight all  
hands employed in ships duty Middle strong  
Later Light two sails in sight Later 37.59 Long 73.14

Monday June 21st 1841  
Light airs from the SE heading to the NW with  
all sail set at the best advantage Middle  
Light Black fish being around the ship took in  
the flying jib and hoove aback the main yard  
Later strong winds from the East three sails in sight  
Lat 28.14 Long 72.53 West

Tuesday June 22nd  
Strong from East heading in to the south  
all hands employed in ships duty and various  
jobs Middle strong Later strong one sail  
in sight

Lat 34.46 Long 72.47 West

Wednesday June 23rd  
Light from south all hands employed in backing  
out at the after hatch driving the Bread and  
Molasses and stowing away again Middle  
light Later the same at 9 am saw Blackfish  
lowered and took three took them along  
side and hoisted them in  
Lat 34.52 - Long 74 15.14 West

Thursday June 24th  
Fresh winds from the SE one sail in sight  
all hands employed in clearing away the  
blackfish and other sundry jobs about the  
ship Middle strong with rain Later Light  
Lat 37.58 Long 66.01 West

Friday June 25th  
Light from the west all hands employed in  
backing out the after hatch and driving stowing  
the Bread and Molasses Middle Calms  
Later fine at 10 AM saw Blackfish lowered  
fastened and drawn came on board and  
hoisted up the boats  
No sail this day

Saturday June 26th  
Light from the North at 1 PM the wind  
hauled from to East saw blackfish lowered  
fastened and drawn Middle and Later Light  
Lat 37.52 Long 64.21
