Saw finbacks Middle Squids with rain.
Later fine employed in boiling out the Whale.
Lat 40.03 Long 34.23 West



Wednesday July 16th
Fine winds from the SE steering on the wind
to the East 2 one sail in sight Middle Light
Later fine and pleasant 5 sails in sight
Long 32.54 Lat 41.25



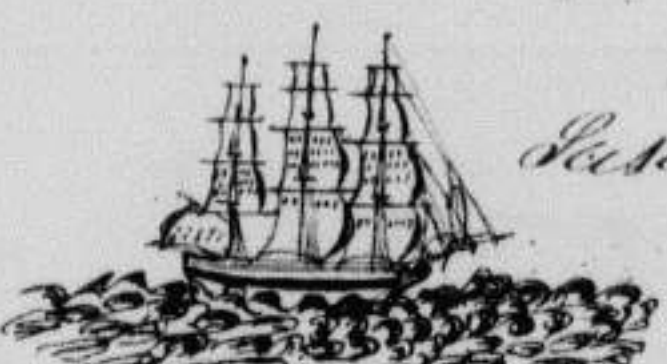
Thursday July 17th
Light from SE steering on the wind to
East with all sail set at the best advantage
5 sails in sight Middle and Latter light
the Mack employed in driving the oil so ends
Lat 40.08 Long 31.42 West

Friday July 18th
Light from the SE steering on the wind to
the SE 5 sails in sight the Mack employed in
driving the oil Middle and Latter Light
Lat 41.00 Long 31.20



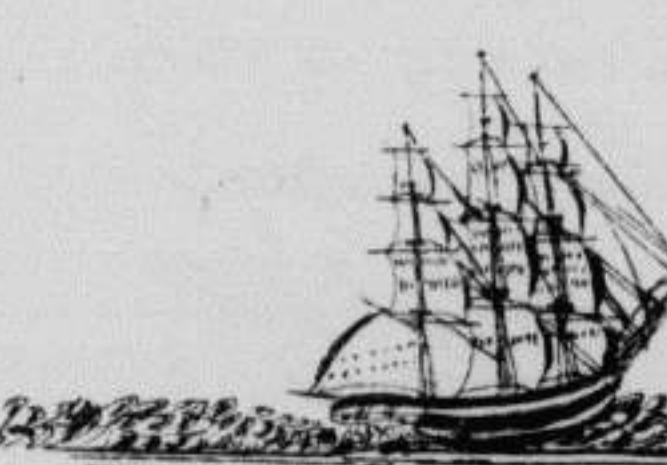
Saturday July 19th
Light from the north steering by West
with all sails set at the best advantage
8 sails in sight at 2 PM the Captain of the
Berge Michine came on board Middle and Latter Light.
Saw one Whim Whale Lat 40.24 Long 34.54

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Susan Ann Bedford
Sunday July 20th
Light from the North in chase of a sperm whale
that was a going fish into the East got up 8 long
with in start the whale see the boat and went down
8 sails in sight at 6 PM went on board of the Susan
of Ann Bedford Capt Howland bound in the Pacific
and found out Long 1.47 Miles East of our Chronometer
Middle light Later the same at 6 saw the Islands
of Flores and Corvo Barring SE dist 50 Miles the Susan
in sight Lat 41.00 Long 31.25

Monday July 21st
Light from the South the Islands of Flores and
Corvo SE point Barring SE SE point of Flores South
running in between them in company with the
Susan of Ann Bedford Middle fine laying
of Flores and Corvo Latter the same running down
to the landing place so ends

Tuesday July 22nd
Fine winds from the North West at 2 PM went
on shore to recruit at 6 came of not accomplished
anything Middle fine Latter the same at 10 AM
went on shore to recruit and sent of our baggage
bushels of potatoes and onions so ends then
24 hours recruiting in company with the
Susan Capt Howland
