Thursday July 22nd
 Strong winds from the SE running down
 for the Island of Sagah in company with
 the Susan of New Bedford 2 sails in sight
 at 6 AM the captain of the Susan came on board
 at 7 AM went on board of his own ship again
 and more of of the land Middle laying of
 and on bent the cables Later beating up to
 the Landing so ends

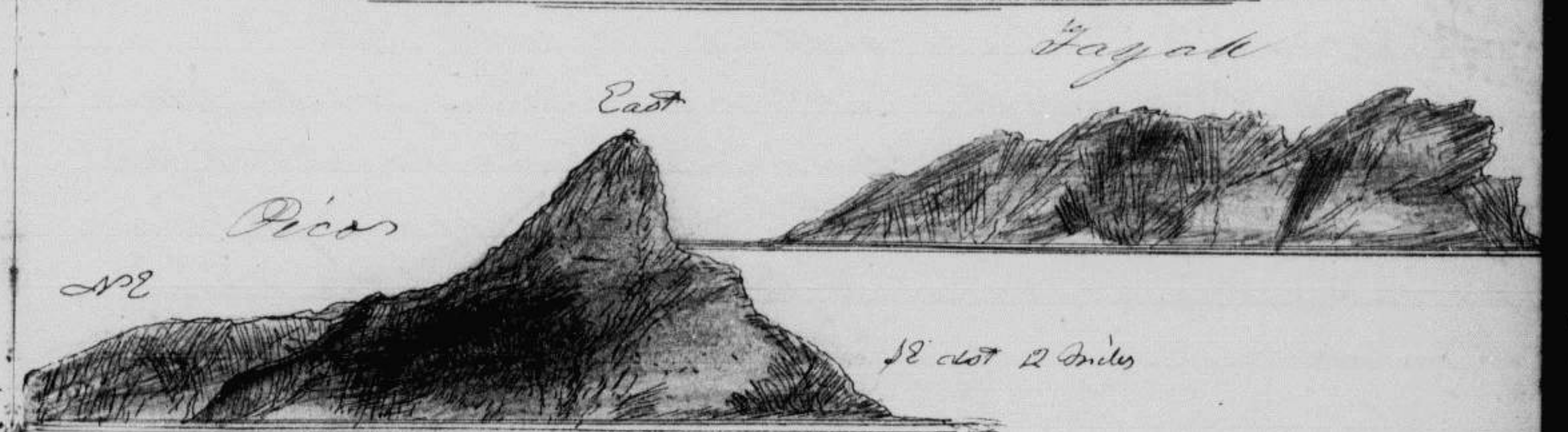


Friday July 23rd
 Light from the North at 4 PM went on shore and
 permit to land the oil at 7 PM the lighters come
 of with the vegetables Middle beating the wind
 all round the compass Later the same at 7 PM the ship
 come of after the oil at 7 PM sent it on shore
 the following ships landing oil Susan 70 bbls Elizabeth 100
 While 50 bbls heroine recruiting and a number of others

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Saturday July 24th
 Light and sailing on shore getting my business and
 waiting for two men to be caught not finding the men
 went out to cruise a few days Middle fine and sailing
 Later fine winds steering to the North so ends

Sunday July 25th
 Light from the South Middle fine Later the same
 3 ships in sight so ends then 24 hours
 Later 39.05



Monday July 26th
 Good winds from the East 3 ships in sight the
 Islands of Sagah Pico Graciosa Saint George
 Veeira Middle fine Later the same so ends

Tuesday July 27th
 Fine winds the Islands in sight saw a plenty
 of grampuses Middle strong Later the same

Wednesday July 28th
 Fine two sails in Middle the same
 Later the same the Islands in sight
