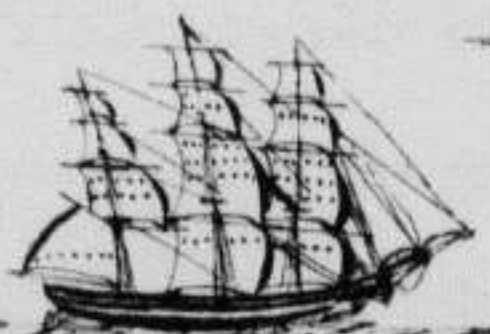


Voyage from Providence to the Pacific

sail at the best advantage Middle squally later fine
Lat 53.09 Long 53.09



Monday October 4th

Strong gales from the South steering on the wind
to the West one sail in sight reefed the topsails Middle
Strong later (more moderate) Lat 54.28 Long 54.45

Tuesday October 5th

Strong from the South steering on the wind to the
S.W. nothing in sight on bent the main course and sent
the new one Middle strong later Moderate
Lat 41.22 Long 54.25 15

Wednesday October 6th

Strong winds from the S.W. steering on the wind
to the S.W. fine backs in sight Middle more
moderate later light Lat 43.08 Long 54.16 West

Thursday October 7th

Light airs from the S.W. steering S.W. by S. fine backs
in sight Middle strong later more moderate peace
Lat 45.50 Long 55.58.30

Friday October 8th

Light airs from the West steering to the S.W. by S.
fine backs in sight Middle fine later the same
Lat 47.19 Long 58.41.50

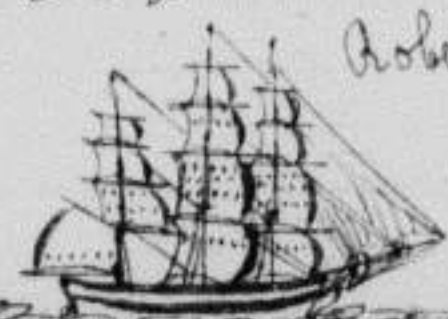

Saturday October 9th

Light from the W.S.W. steering S.W. by S. nothing
in sight Middle and later fine and pleasant
Lat 48.19 Long 59.30 "

Sunday October 10th

Fine from the S.W. steering S.W. one sail in sight
Middle at 12 past 6 pm spoke the Robert Edwards of
Acadeford Capt. Burges Middle fine winds later
Strong gales from the S.W. 60.25 Long 62.31 West



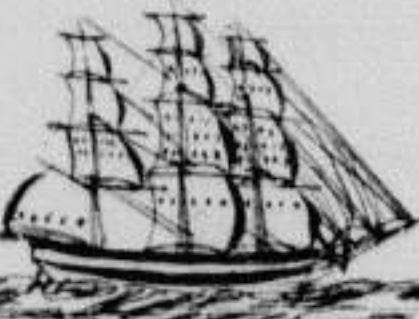

Monday October 11th

More moderate from the S.W. steering S.W. by S. the Robert
Edwards in sight Middle fine later strong gales from
North nothing in sight so ends Lat 43.00 Long 53.41.15.

Tuesday October 12th

Strong from the North steering S.W. nothing in sight
Middle strong gales later heavy from the South
one sail in sight No obs this day



Wednesday October 13th

More moderate gales but a very heavy sea running
Middle more moderate later the same but the fore
top sail and main course and jib
Lat 53.10 Long forenoon 13.59

Thursday October 14th

Strong from the South Middle and later light and calm
Lat 53.40 Long 53.51
