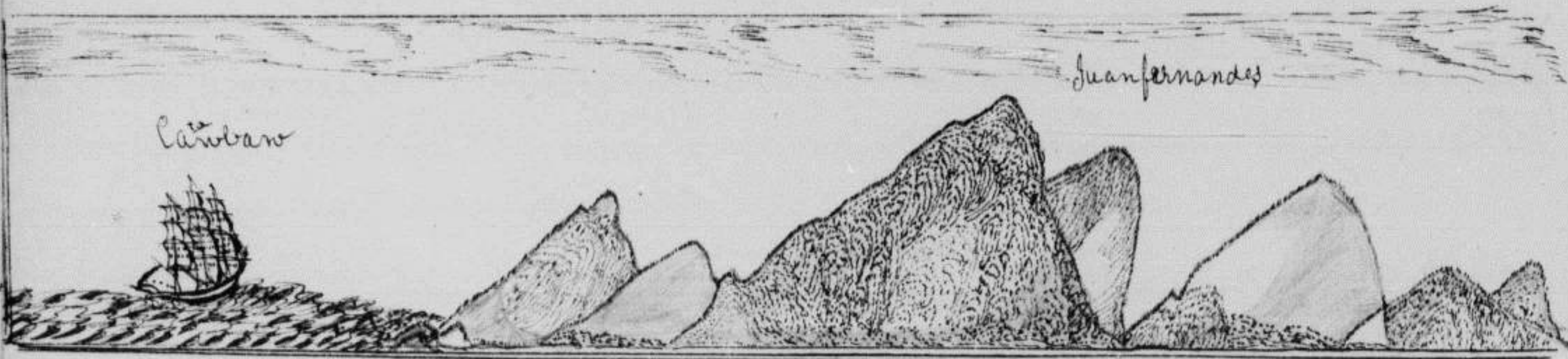


A Voyage from Providence to the Pacific

Fresh gales from the SE Steering N by E Middle Strong later more moderate Lat none one sail in sight

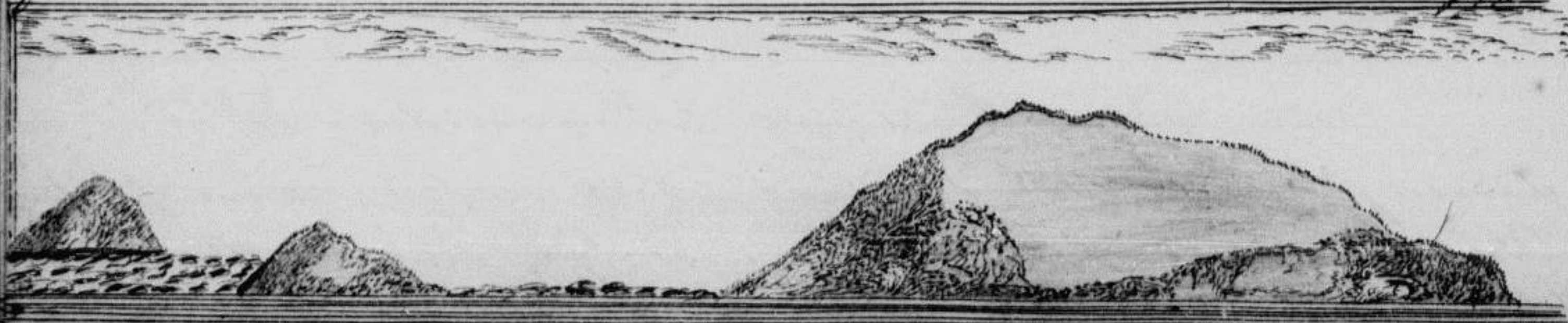


Sunday November 7<sup>th</sup>

Strong from the SE Steering with finbacks in sight Middle Strong later the same finbacks in sight  
Lat 17.55 Long 79.28.30

Friday November 12<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze from the SE Steering N by E with all sail set at the best advantage Middle Strong later the same  
Lat 15.01 Long 79.35.00

Saturday November 13<sup>th</sup>

Fresh breeze from the SE Steering N by E finbacks in sight Middle squally weather later fine  
Lat 12.58 Long 80.00.00

Sunday November 14<sup>th</sup>

Fine from SE Steering N by E nothing in sight at 4 PM took in sail for the night Middle squally weather later at 8 PM spoke the Tobias of Wampanoag 15 months out one thousand bars of sperm oil later fine  
Lat 12.20 Long 80.09.15
