Saturday January 28th
 Fine from 10 the boats of chasing whales at 12 fasten
 and killed the whale took him along side and
 cut him in middle fine later the same
 Lat 61.46 Long 81.46.00

Sunday January 29th
 Fine from the E. side nothing in sight employ
 in buying Miadec and later fine Lat 65.31 81.26

Monday January 30th
 Strong from the S. on the land to the East nothing
 in sight Miadec and later the same
 Lat 6.28. Long

Tuesday January 31st
 Strong from the S. the land in sight Miadec
 and later the same Lat 61.19 Long none

Wednesday January 1st
 Strong from the S. running down the land
 Miadec fine Lat the same and sperm Whales
 and lowered so ends this day



Thursday January 2nd
 Fine from the S. chasing whales at 5pm
 fastened to two whales killed them and took them
 along side Miadec fine Lat Strong at
 5pm began to cut & past & finished Lat 6.27 Long

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Friday January 28th
 Strong from the S. the land in sight Miadec
 Strong later more moderate at 12 finished boiling
 Lat 65.26 Long 81.26

Saturday January 29th
 Strong running down for payta at head of
 the land Middle fine Lat the same a strong
 current setting to the north being up to payta



Sunday January 30th
 Fine at 3pm went on shore at payta shipped two men
 and took 6 bushels of potatoes at 2 dls per barrel
 at 6pm came on board and stood out to sea Miadec
 and later fine spoke the Joseph Seaywell of New Bedford
 120 tons 900 spoke the Barque Rajer of do. 500 100...



Monday January 31st
 Fine from the south running to the north in company
 with Rajer capt West Middle fine later the same

Tuesday January 1st
 Light running down the land for Tombes one sail
 in sight at 6pm came to with the L. board
 anchor the Barque Columbus lying at anchor
 Capt Peace 220 tons 100 dls at 7 the Barque Rajer
 Capt West came to Lat's fine so ends
