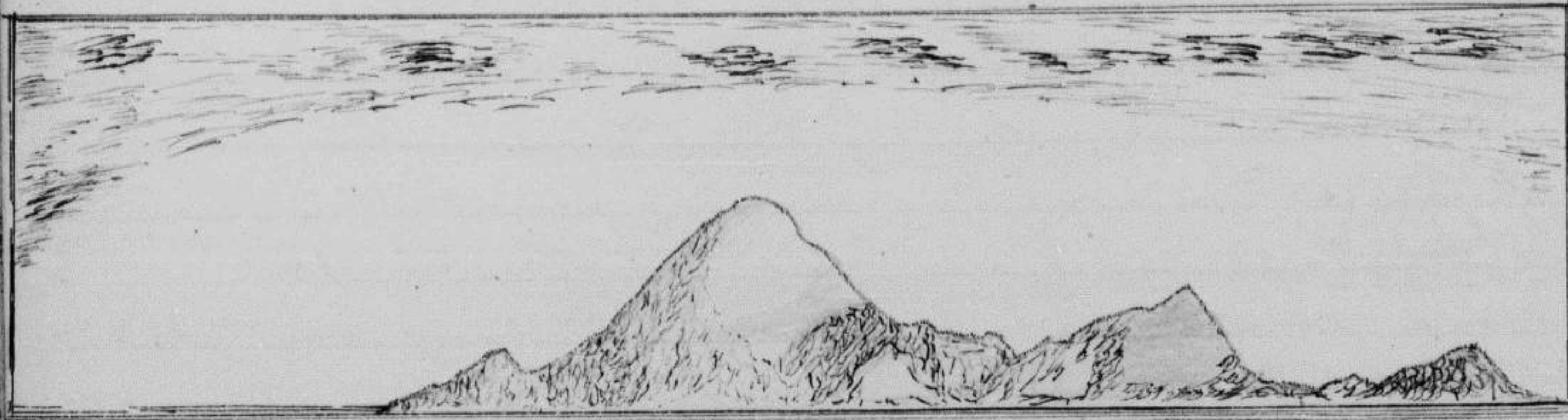
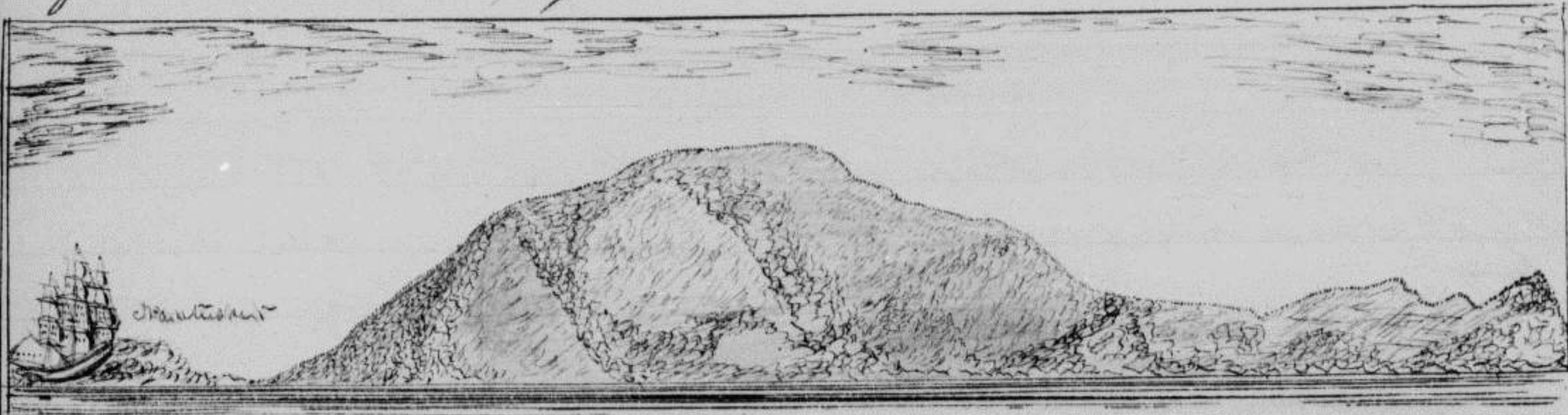


Ship Lion on the passage to the of shore grounds 1842

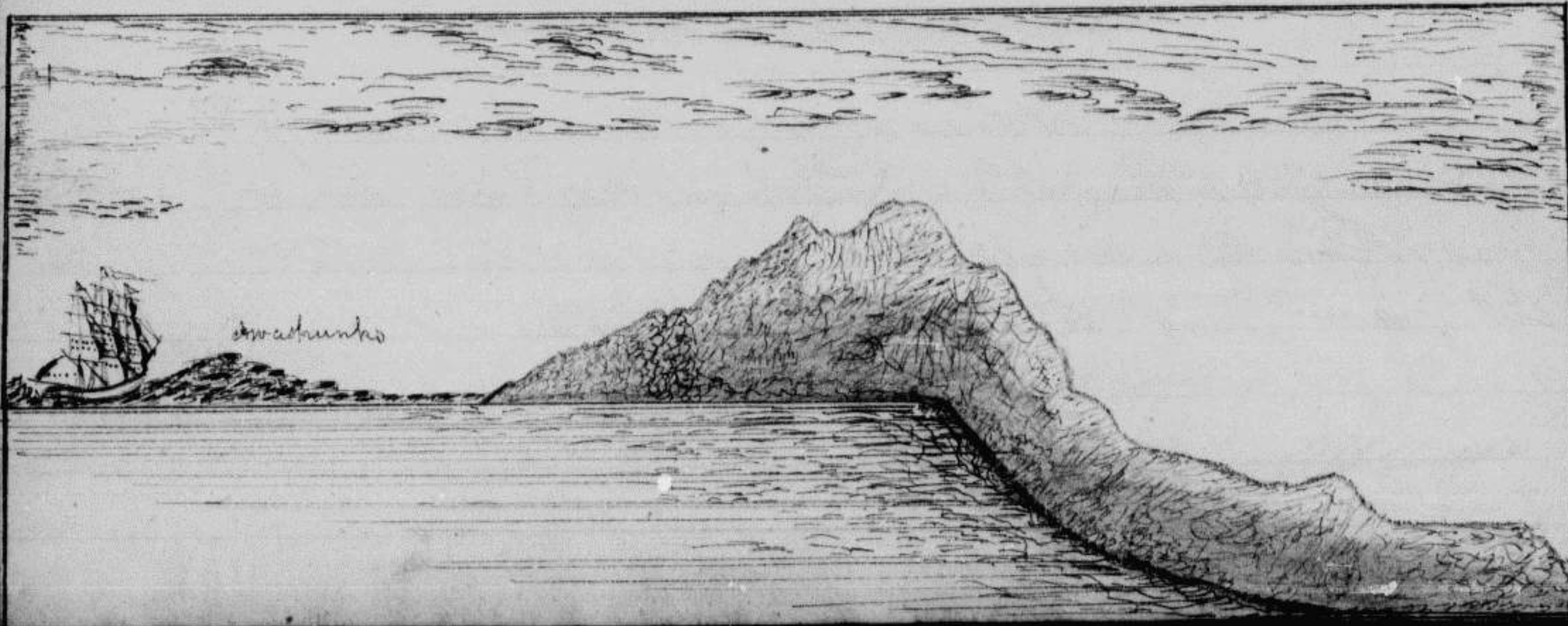
Thursday March 17th
