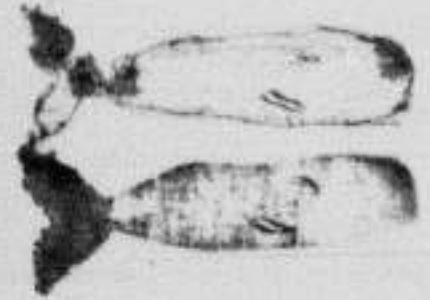


Ship Lion Cruising on the line in 1842

fine later the same Lat 4.21 Long 140.21.15

Wednesday August 10th
Sailed from the SB on the wind to the south nothing
in sight midday and later strong Lat 6.11 Long 140.39.45

Thursday August 11th
Sailed from the SB on the wind to the south nothing in
sight midday and later heavy wind Lat 7.52 Long 140.46.15

Friday August 12th
Sailed from the SB on the wind to the south nothing in
sight midday at 4 pm saw the islands of Fatoua and
Robertson's Islands midday and later the same
Lat 8.21 South Long 139.44.15
