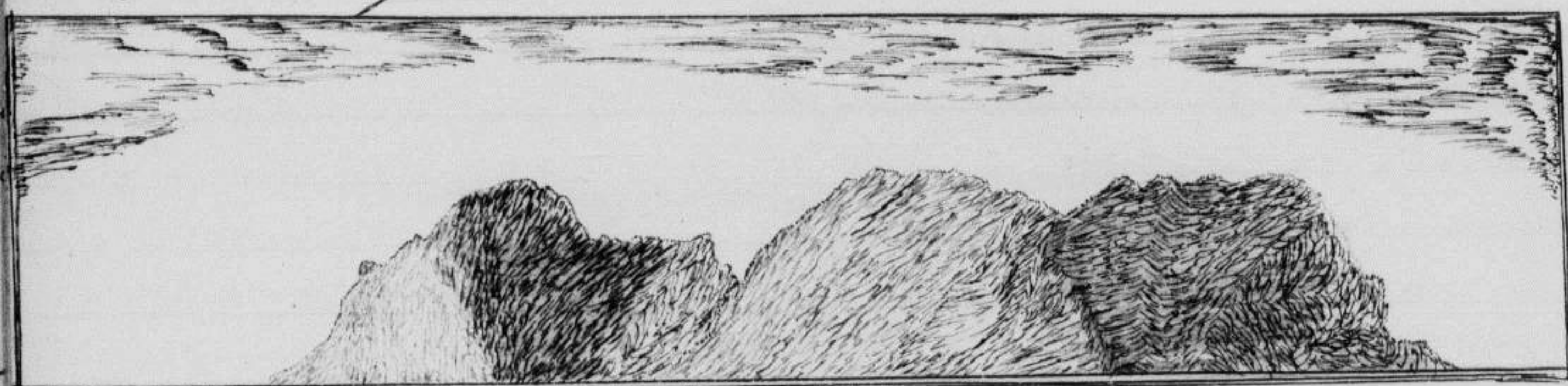


Ship Lion of the Marquesas in 1842

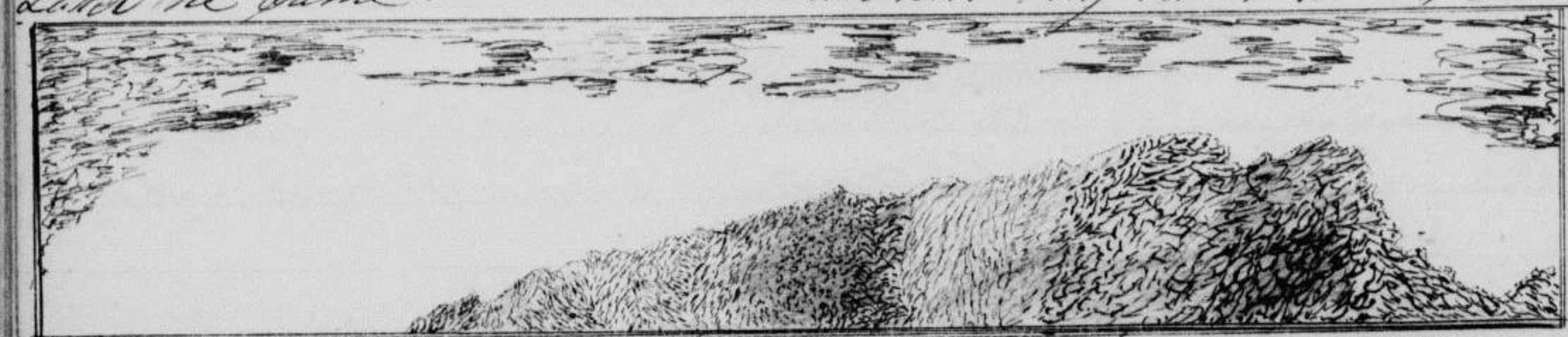
Saturday August 13th

Strong from the E on the wind to the SE running for the Island of Suvaoka Middle fine later the same at 5 pm went on shore after potatoes a French sugar and a sheep of wool at anchor the Eliza Capt Chase 13 months before the Hariner Capt Palmer 2 months 1842



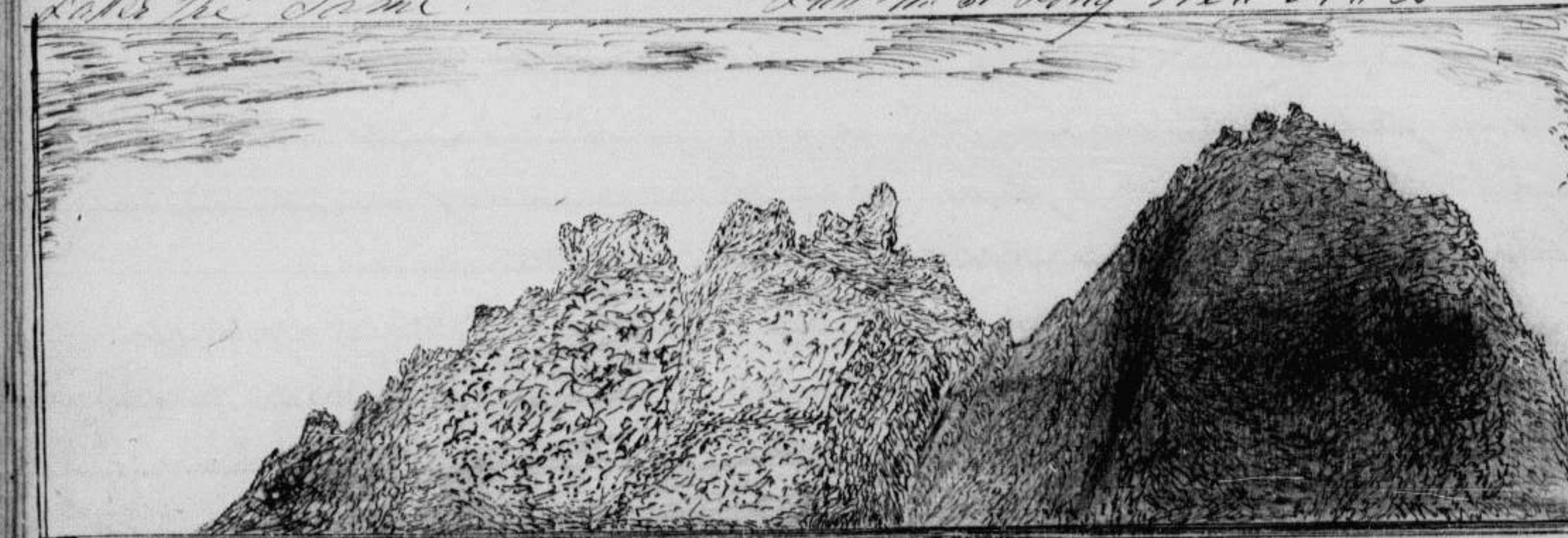
Sunday August 14th

Strong from the SE laying off and on the Island of Suvaoka with two boats on shore at 5 pm came off with 10 barrels of potatoes and kept the ship away for Suvaoka Middle fine later the same



Monday August 15th

Strong from the SE steering SE by S nothing in sight middle and later the same



Ship Lion on her passage to the Society Islands

Tuesday August 16th

Strong from the SE steering SE middle and later the same with the day 13.12 Long 144.48.15

Wednesday August 17th

Strong from the SE steering SE by S middle and later fine at 11 am saw the Island Oibeha in sight

Lat 14.20 Long 146.08.15

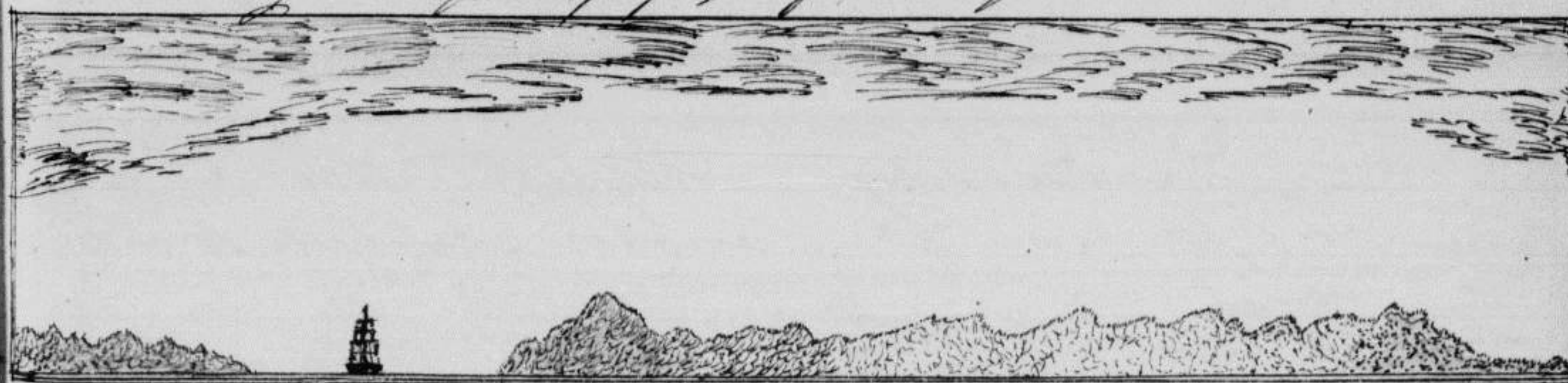
Thursday August 18th

Strong from the SE steering SE nothing in sight middle the same at noon ship to the North at 1 pm in for the land with the same at 8 am past the Island of Seans So ends

Lat 15.01 Long 147.08.15

Friday August 19th

Strong from the SE running down Seans Island Middle hauled off the land at 1 pm in shore later strong from SE running through the passage of Seavinton and Seans Islands



Saturday August 20th

Strong from the SE on the wind to the SE by S nothing in sight middle and later the same
