Sunday August 21st

Strong from the S.E. on the wind to the S.W. at 3 p.m. saw the Island of Taitou at 4.5 p.m. saw the Islands of Tehiti and ~~Paia~~ ^{Maia} ~~Maia~~ strong to the sea



Monday August 22nd

Strong backing up to Tahiti at 3 being under the Land the wind left us ^{Maia} and fine it took the pilot so ends



Tuesday August 23rd

Time at 6 p.m. came at an anchor at Tahiti so ends

Sunday September 11th

Lying of and on waiting for the boat at 8 p.m. the boat came on board ^{Maia} and later fine the Boat in sight so ends

Monday Sept 12th

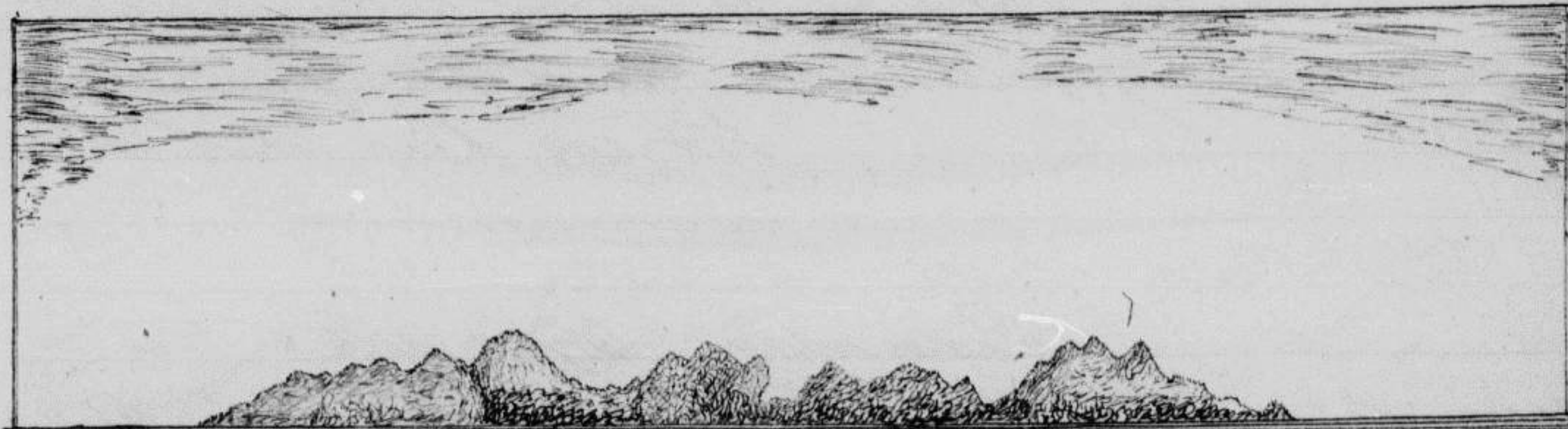
Strong from the west steering S by N nothing the Island of Tehiti and Maia in sight ^{Maia} the same at 10 a.m. passed the Island of ^{Maia} later strong to the sea

Tuesday Sept 13th

Strong from the S.E. steering S by N ^{Maia} the same later more moderate Lat 16.31 Long 148.00.15

Wednesday Sept 14th

More moderate steering S by N nothing in sight ^{Maia} later strong gales with squalls ^{Maia} in sight Lat 16.25 Long 148.55.15



Thursday Sept 15th

Strong gales from the S.E. at 2 p.m. luffed on the wind to the south it being too thick to run through ^{Maia} ^{Maia} and clear islands ^{Maia} and later the same so ends
